# 1 John 5

Chapter 5 of 5 · 21 Verses · Authorized King James Version

#### Faith in the Son of God

- <sup>1</sup> Whosoever believeth that Jesus is the Christ is born of God: and every one that loveth him that begat loveth him also that is begotten of him.
- <sup>2</sup> By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God, and keep his commandments.
- <sup>3</sup> For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments: and his commandments are not grievous.
- <sup>4</sup> For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and this is the victory that overcometh the world, even our faith.
- <sup>5</sup> Who is he that overcometh the world, but he that believeth that Jesus is the Son of God?

# Witnesses to the Son

- <sup>6</sup> This is he that came by water and blood, even Jesus Christ; not by water only, but by water and blood. And it is the Spirit that beareth witness, because the Spirit is truth.
- <sup>7</sup> For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one.
- <sup>8</sup> And there are three that bear witness in earth, the Spirit, and the water, and the blood: and these three agree in one.
- <sup>9</sup> If we receive the witness of men, the witness of God is greater: for this is the witness of God which he hath testified of his Son.

- <sup>10</sup> He that believeth on the Son of God hath the witness in himself: he that believeth not God hath made him a liar; because he believeth not the record that God gave of his Son.
- <sup>11</sup> And this is the record, that God hath given to us eternal life, and this life is in his Son.
- <sup>12</sup> He that hath the Son hath life; and he that hath not the Son of God hath not life.

# **Confidence in Prayer**

- <sup>13</sup> These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God.
- <sup>14</sup> And this is the confidence that we have in him, that, if we ask any thing according to his will, he heareth us:
- <sup>15</sup> And if we know that he hear us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of him.

## **Prayer for Sinners**

- <sup>16</sup> If any man see his brother sin a sin which is not unto death, he shall ask, and he shall give him life for them that sin not unto death. There is a sin unto death: I do not say that he shall pray for it.
- $^{17}$  All unrighteousness is sin: and there is a sin not unto death.
- <sup>18</sup> We know that whosoever is born of God sinneth not; but he that is begotten of God keepeth himself, and that wicked one toucheth him not.
- $^{19}$  And we know that we are of God, and the whole world lieth in wickedness.
- <sup>20</sup> And we know that the Son of God is come, and hath given us an understanding, that we may know him that is true, and we are in him that is true, even in his Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God, and eternal life.
- <sup>21</sup> Little children, keep yourselves from idols. Amen.

#### **HEBREW & GREEK WORD STUDIES**

#### **Believe** — πιστεύω (Pisteuo)

To believe, trust, have faith

The Greek **pisteuo** (πιστεύω) means to believe or trust—active reliance upon Christ. 'For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish' (John 3:16).

# **Blood** — αἷμα (Haima)

Blood

The Greek **haima** ( $\alpha \tilde{i} \mu \alpha$ ) denotes blood. Christ's blood 'cleanseth us from all sin' (1 John 1:7), securing 'eternal redemption' (Hebrews 9:12) through His once-for-all sacrifice. Believers have been 'purchased with his own blood' (Acts 20:28).

# Born Again — γεννάω ἄνωθεν (Gennao

Anothen)

Born again, born from above

The Greek phrase combines **gennao** (to beget/birth) with **anothen** (from above/again). Jesus told Nicodemus, 'Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God' (John 3:3)—a spiritual rebirth by the Holy Spirit.

# Eternal — αἰώνιος (Aiōnios)

Eternal, everlasting

The Greek **aiōnios** (αἰώνιος) denotes eternal or everlasting—unending duration. Believers possess 'eternal life' (John 3:16) now and will dwell with God eternally, while the impenitent face 'eternal punishment' (Matthew 25:46).

#### **Faith** — πίστις (Pistis)

Faith, belief, trust

The Greek **pistis** ( $\pi$ i $\sigma$ tr $\varsigma$ ) denotes faith, belief, or trust—confidence in God's character and promises. It's both intellectual assent and relational trust, central to justification (Romans 5:1).

#### **God** — Θεός (Theos)

God

The Greek **Theos** ( $\Theta \epsilon \acute{o} \varsigma$ ) refers to deity, used both for the one true God and false gods. Context determines whether it denotes the Father specifically or the Godhead generally.

# **Heaven** — οὐρανός (Ouranos)

Heaven, sky

The Greek **ouranos** (οὐρανός) denotes heaven—God's throne and the believer's eternal home. Jesus taught His disciples to pray 'Our Father which art in heaven' (Matthew 6:9) and promised to prepare a place there (John 14:2).

#### **Holy** — ἄγιος (Hagios)

Holy, sacred, set apart

The Greek **hagios** (ἄγιος) denotes holiness—moral purity and separation unto God. Believers are called 'saints' (hagioi), those set apart for God through Christ's sanctifying work.

## **Love** — ἀγάπη (Agape)

Divine love

The Greek **agape** ( $\dot{\alpha}\gamma\dot{\alpha}\pi\eta$ ) denotes self-sacrificial, unconditional love—the highest form of love, characterizing God's nature (1 John 4:8) and the love Christians are called to demonstrate.

#### Sin — ἀμαρτία (Hamartia)

Sin, missing the mark

The Greek **hamartia** ( $\dot{\alpha}\mu\alpha\rho\tau(\alpha)$  means sin—missing the target of God's perfection. 'All have sinned and fall short of the glory of God' (Romans 3:23), requiring Christ's atoning sacrifice.

# Spirit — πνεῦμα (Pneuma)

Spirit, wind, breath

The Greek **pneuma** ( $\pi\nu\epsilon\tilde{\nu}\mu\alpha$ ) means spirit, wind, or breath—the immaterial aspect of persons. The Holy Spirit (Pneuma Hagion) is the third person of the Trinity, dwelling in believers.

#### **Truth** — ἀλήθεια (Aletheia)

Truth, reality

The Greek **aletheia** (ἀλήθεια) denotes truth or reality—that which corresponds to actuality. Jesus declared, 'I am the way, the truth, and the life' (John 14:6), embodying ultimate reality.
