

# 1 Peter 5:4

Authorized King James Version (KJV)

And when the chief Shepherd shall appear, ye shall receive a crown of glory that fadeth not away.

## Analysis

---

Peter promises reward: unfading crown of glory when Chief Shepherd appears. Faithful service yields future glory. Accountability to Chief Shepherd restrains abuse.

## Historical Context

---

Faithful elders receive eternal reward. This eschatological hope motivated endurance. Chief Shepherd establishes hierarchy.

## Additional Cross-References

**James 1:12** (Parallel theme): Blessed is the man that endureth temptation: for when he is tried, he shall receive the crown of life, which the Lord hath promised to them that love him.

**1 Corinthians 9:25** (Parallel theme): And every man that striveth for the mastery is temperate in all things. Now they do it to obtain a corruptible crown; but we an incorruptible.

**1 John 3:2** (Parallel theme): Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is.

**Daniel 12:3** (Parallel theme): And they that be wise shall shine as the brightness of the firmament; and they that turn many to righteousness as the stars for ever and ever.

**1 Peter 2:25** (Parallel theme): For ye were as sheep going astray; but are now returned unto the Shepherd and Bishop of your souls.

**1 Peter 1:4** (Parallel theme): To an inheritance incorruptible, and undefiled, and that fadeth not away, reserved in heaven for you,

**Revelation 2:10** (Parallel theme): Fear none of those things which thou shalt suffer: behold, the devil shall cast some of you into prison, that ye may be tried; and ye shall have tribulation ten days: be thou faithful unto death, and I will give thee a crown of life.
