Greeting

- ¹ The elder unto the elect lady and her children, whom I love in the truth; and not I only, but also all they that have known the truth;
- ² For the truth's sake, which dwelleth in us, and shall be with us for ever.
- ³ Grace be with you, mercy, and peace, from God the Father, and from the Lord Jesus Christ, the Son of the Father, in truth and love.

Walking in Truth and Love

- ⁴ I rejoiced greatly that I found of thy children walking in truth, as we have received a commandment from the Father.
- ⁵ And now I beseech thee, lady, not as though I wrote a new commandment unto thee, but that which we had from the beginning, that we love one another.
- ⁶ And this is love, that we walk after his commandments. This is the commandment, That, as ye have heard from the beginning, ye should walk in it.

Warning Against Deceivers

- ⁷ For many deceivers are entered into the world, who confess not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh. This is a deceiver and an antichrist.
- ⁸ Look to yourselves, that we lose not those things which we have wrought, but that we receive a full reward.
- ⁹ Whosoever transgresseth, and abideth not in the doctrine of Christ, hath not God. He that abideth in the doctrine of Christ, he hath both the Father and the Son.

- 10 If there come any unto you, and bring not this doctrine, receive him not into your house, neither bid him God speed:
- ¹¹ For he that biddeth him God speed is partaker of his evil deeds.

Final Greetings

- ¹² Having many things to write unto you, I would not write with paper and ink: but I trust to come unto you, and speak face to face, that our joy may be full.
- ¹³ The children of thy elect sister greet thee. Amen.

HEBREW & GREEK WORD STUDIES

Confess — ὁμολογέω (Homologeo)

To confess, acknowledge, agree

The Greek **homologeo** (ὁμολογέω) means to say the same thing—agreeing with God about sin or truth. 'If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins' (1 John 1:9).

Elect — ἐκλεκτός (Eklektos)

Elect, chosen

The Greek **eklektos** (ἐκλεκτός) means chosen or elect—those selected by God. Believers are 'elect according to the foreknowledge of God the Father' (1 Peter 1:2).

God — Θεός (Theos)

God

The Greek **Theos** ($\Theta \epsilon \acute{o}\varsigma$) refers to deity, used both for the one true God and false gods. Context determines whether it denotes the Father specifically or the Godhead generally.

Grace — χάρις (Charis)

Grace, favor

The Greek **charis** ($\chi \acute{\alpha} \rho \iota \varsigma$) denotes unmerited divine favor—God's kindness toward the undeserving. Salvation is 'by grace through faith' (Ephesians 2:8), not human merit.

Love — ἀγάπη (Agape)

Divine love

The Greek **agape** ($\dot{\alpha}\gamma\dot{\alpha}\pi\eta$) denotes self-sacrificial, unconditional love—the highest form of love, characterizing God's nature (1 John 4:8) and the love Christians are called to demonstrate.

Truth — ἀλήθεια (Aletheia)

Truth, reality

The Greek **aletheia** (ἀλήθεια) denotes truth or reality—that which corresponds to actuality. Jesus declared, 'I am the way, the truth, and the life' (John 14:6), embodying ultimate reality.
