**6** And to knowledge temperance; and to temperance patience; and to patience godliness;



7 And to godliness brotherly kindness; and to brotherly kindness charity.

**10** Wherefore the rather, brethren, give diligence to make your calling and election sure: for if ye do these things, ye shall never fall:



11 For so an entrance shall be ministered unto you abundantly into the everlasting kingdom of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.



12 Wherefore I will not be negligent to put you always in remembrance of these things, though ye know them, and be established in the present truth.



13 Yea, I think it meet, as long as I am in this tabernacle, to stir you up by putting you in remembrance:


