# 2 Samuel 8

Chapter 8 of 24 · 18 Verses · Authorized King James Version

## **David's Military Victories**

- <sup>1</sup> And after this it came to pass, that David smote the Philistines, and subdued them: and David took Metheg-ammah out of the hand of the Philistines.
- <sup>2</sup> And he smote Moab, and measured them with a line, casting them down to the ground; even with two lines measured he to put to death, and with one full line to keep alive. And so the Moabites became David's servants, and brought gifts.
- <sup>3</sup> David smote also Hadadezer, the son of Rehob, king of Zobah, as he went to recover his border at the river Euphrates.
- <sup>4</sup> And David took from him a thousand chariots, and seven hundred horsemen, and twenty thousand footmen: and David houghed all the chariot horses, but reserved of them for an hundred chariots.
- <sup>5</sup> And when the Syrians of Damascus came to succour Hadadezer king of Zobah, David slew of the Syrians two and twenty thousand men.
- <sup>6</sup> Then David put garrisons in Syria of Damascus: and the Syrians became servants to David, and brought gifts. And the LORD preserved David whithersoever he went.
- $^{7}$  And David took the shields of gold that were on the servants of Hadadezer, and brought them to Jerusalem.
- <sup>8</sup> And from Betah, and from Berothai, cities of Hadadezer, king David took exceeding much brass.
- $^{9}$  When Toi king of Hamath heard that David had smitten all the host of Hadadezer,
- <sup>10</sup> Then Toi sent Joram his son unto king David, to salute him, and to bless him, because he had fought against Hadadezer, and smitten him: for Hadadezer had wars

with Toi. And Joram brought with him vessels of silver, and vessels of gold, and vessels of brass:

- Which also king David did dedicate unto the LORD, with the silver and gold that he had dedicated of all nations which he subdued;
- <sup>12</sup> Of Syria, and of Moab, and of the children of Ammon, and of the Philistines, and of Amalek, and of the spoil of Hadadezer, son of Rehob, king of Zobah.
- <sup>13</sup> And David gat him a name when he returned from smiting of the Syrians in the valley of salt, being eighteen thousand men.
- <sup>14</sup> And he put garrisons in Edom; throughout all Edom put he garrisons, and all they of Edom became David's servants. And the LORD preserved David whithersoever he went.

#### **David's Officials**

- <sup>15</sup> And David reigned over all Israel; and David executed judgment and justice unto all his people.
- <sup>16</sup> And Joab the son of Zeruiah was over the host; and Jehoshaphat the son of Ahilud was recorder;
- <sup>17</sup> And Zadok the son of Ahitub, and Ahimelech the son of Abiathar, were the priests; and Seraiah was the scribe;
- <sup>18</sup> And Benaiah the son of Jehoiada was over both the Cherethites and the Pelethites; and David's sons were chief rulers.

### **HEBREW & GREEK WORD STUDIES**

Judgment — מִשְׁפַט (Mishpat)

Judgment, justice

The Hebrew **mishpat** (מִשְׁפֵּט) means judgment or justice—God's righteous decisions and ordinances. God is the Judge of all the earth who 'shall do right' (Genesis 18:25), executing perfect justice.

**Lord** — יָהוָה / אֲדֹנֵי (YHWH / Adonai)

The LORD / Lord

When 'LORD' appears in small capitals, it represents the Tetragrammaton **YHWH** (יְהוָה), God's personal covenant name meaning 'I AM.' When 'Lord' appears normally, it's **Adonai** (אֲדֹנֵי), meaning 'my Lord,' emphasizing sovereignty.

Priest — כֹהֵן (Kohen)

**Priest** 

The Hebrew **kohen** (פֹהֵן) denotes a priest—one who mediates between God and people through sacrifices and intercession. Aaron and his descendants served as Israel's priests, foreshadowing Christ the Great High Priest.
