

# Acts 10:38

Authorized King James Version (KJV)

How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.

## Analysis

Peter testified: 'How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.' The anointing with the Spirit (at Jesus' baptism) equipped Christ for His messianic ministry. Peter summarized Jesus' earthly work - doing good, healing, and liberating those oppressed by Satan. This demonstrates Christ's power over demonic forces and His compassionate ministry. Reformed Christology maintains that Christ's human nature, though sinless, needed the Spirit's empowerment for ministry, modeling Spirit-dependence for all ministry.

## Historical Context

Jesus' ministry occurred circa AD 27-30 throughout Galilee, Judea, and surrounding regions. His healing and deliverance ministry demonstrated the kingdom of God breaking into Satan's domain (Luke 11:20). Peter and the apostles were eyewitnesses to these works (v.39).

**Luke 4:18** (Spirit): The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he hath anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he hath sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised,
