

# Acts 18:1

Authorized King James Version (KJV)

After these things Paul departed from Athens, and came to Corinth;

## Analysis

---

Paul 'departed from Athens, and came to Corinth' - moving from philosophy's capital to commerce's hub. Corinth was strategically located on the isthmus connecting mainland Greece. The shift from Athens' intellectualism to Corinth's cosmopolitanism required adjusted ministry approach.

## Historical Context

---

Corinth was a major commercial center, rebuilt by Julius Caesar in 44 BC as a Roman colony. Its strategic location made it a crossroads of Mediterranean trade and culture.

**Acts 19:1** (References Paul): And it came to pass, that, while Apollos was at Corinth, Paul having passed through the upper coasts came to Ephesus: and finding certain disciples,

**1 Corinthians 1:2** (Parallel theme): Unto the church of God which is at Corinth, to them that are sanctified in Christ Jesus, called to be saints, with all that in every place call upon the name of Jesus Christ our Lord, both their's and our's:

**2 Timothy 4:20** (Parallel theme): Erastus abode at Corinth: but Trophimus have I left at Miletum sick.
