Analysis

'Therefore watch, and remember, that by the space of three years I ceased not to warn every one night and day with tears.' Paul's emotional investment over three years modeled pastoral vigilance. 'Night and day with tears' shows constant, compassionate care.

Historical Context

Three years of sustained, emotional ministry established the pattern elders should continue. Paul's tears demonstrated genuine love underlying his warnings.

Additional Cross-References

Acts 19:10 (Parallel theme): And this continued by the space of two years; so that all they which dwelt in Asia heard the word of the Lord Jesus, both Jews and Greeks.
