

# Acts 20:32

Authorized King James Version (KJV)

And now, brethren, I commend you to God, and to the word of his grace, which is able to build you up, and to give you an inheritance among all them which are sanctified.

## Analysis

---

Paul's final commendation - 'I commend you to God, and to the word of his grace' - identifies the twin foundations for Christian perseverance: God's person and His revealed Word. The 'word of his grace' doesn't merely inform but actively 'builds up' and gives inheritance. This confidence in Scripture's power through the Spirit's work remains the church's hope across generations.

## Historical Context

---

This farewell to the Ephesian elders (whom Paul expected never to see again, verse 25) established their spiritual resources for continuing ministry after his departure. His emphasis on Word over personality cult provided healthy foundation.

## Additional Cross-References

**Colossians 1:12** (Holy): Giving thanks unto the Father, which hath made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light:

**Acts 26:18** (Holy): To open their eyes, and to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan unto God, that they may receive forgiveness of sins, and inheritance among them which are sanctified by faith that is in me.

**Jeremiah 3:19** (Parallel theme): But I said, How shall I put thee among the children, and give thee a pleasant land, a goodly heritage of the hosts of nations? and I said, Thou shalt call me, My father; and shalt not turn away from me.

**Acts 20:24** (Grace): But none of these things move me, neither count I my life dear unto myself, so that I might finish my course with joy, and the ministry, which I have received of the Lord Jesus, to testify the gospel of the grace of God.

**Ephesians 5:5** (References God): For this ye know, that no whoremonger, nor unclean person, nor covetous man, who is an idolater, hath any inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and of God.
