## The New Life in Christ

- <sup>1</sup> If ye then be risen with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ sitteth on the right hand of God.
- <sup>2</sup> Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth.
- <sup>3</sup> For ye are dead, and your life is hid with Christ in God.
- <sup>4</sup> When Christ, who is our life, shall appear, then shall ye also appear with him in glory.

#### Put to Death the Old Self

- <sup>5</sup> Mortify therefore your members which are upon the earth; fornication, uncleanness, inordinate affection, evil concupiscence, and covetousness, which is idolatry:
- <sup>6</sup> For which things' sake the wrath of God cometh on the children of disobedience:
- $^{7}$  In the which ye also walked some time, when ye lived in them.
- <sup>8</sup> But now ye also put off all these; anger, wrath, malice, blasphemy, filthy communication out of your mouth.
- $^{9}$  Lie not one to another, seeing that ye have put off the old man with his deeds;
- <sup>10</sup> And have put on the new man, which is renewed in knowledge after the image of him that created him:
- Where there is neither Greek nor Jew, circumcision nor uncircumcision, Barbarian, Scythian, bond nor free: but Christ is all, and in all.

#### Put on the New Self

- <sup>12</sup> Put on therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, bowels of mercies, kindness, humbleness of mind, meekness, longsuffering;
- Forbearing one another, and forgiving one another, if any man have a quarrel against any: even as Christ forgave you, so also do ye.
- <sup>14</sup> And above all these things put on charity, which is the bond of perfectness.
- <sup>15</sup> And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to the which also ye are called in one body; and be ye thankful.
- <sup>16</sup> Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom; teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.
- $^{17}$  And whatsoever ye do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God and the Father by him.

#### **Christian Household Rules**

- $^{18}$  Wives, submit yourselves unto your own husbands, as it is fit in the Lord.
- <sup>19</sup> Husbands, love your wives, and be not bitter against them.
- <sup>20</sup> Children, obey your parents in all things: for this is well pleasing unto the Lord.
- <sup>21</sup> Fathers, provoke not your children to anger, lest they be discouraged.
- <sup>22</sup> Servants, obey in all things your masters according to the flesh; not with eyeservice, as menpleasers; but in singleness of heart, fearing God:
- $^{23}$  And whatsoever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men;
- <sup>24</sup> Knowing that of the Lord ye shall receive the reward of the inheritance: for ye serve the Lord Christ.

<sup>25</sup> But he that doeth wrong shall receive for the wrong which he hath done: and there is no respect of persons.

#### **HEBREW & GREEK WORD STUDIES**

## **Elect** — ἐκλεκτός (Eklektos)

Elect, chosen

The Greek **eklektos** (ἐκλεκτός) means chosen or elect—those selected by God. Believers are 'elect according to the foreknowledge of God the Father' (1 Peter 1:2).

# **Glory** — δόξα (Doxa)

Glory, majesty, splendor

The Greek **doxa** ( $\delta\delta\xi\alpha$ ) means glory, splendor, or magnificence—the radiant manifestation of God's perfection. Christ revealed the Father's glory: 'we beheld his glory' (John 1:14).

#### **God** — Θεός (Theos)

God

The Greek **Theos** ( $\Theta \epsilon \acute{o} \varsigma$ ) refers to deity, used both for the one true God and false gods. Context determines whether it denotes the Father specifically or the Godhead generally.

# **Holy** — ἄγιος (Hagios)

Holy, sacred, set apart

The Greek **hagios** (lphayıocapca) denotes holiness—moral purity and separation unto God. Believers are called 'saints' (hagioi), those set apart for God through Christ's sanctifying work.

## **Lord** — Κύριος (Kurios)

Lord, Master

The Greek **Kurios** ( $K\acute{o}\rho\iota o\varsigma$ ) means 'lord' or 'master,' used both for human masters and divinely for God the Father and Jesus Christ. Its application to Jesus affirms His deity, as it translates YHWH in the Septuagint.

### **Love** — ἀγάπη (Agape)

Divine love

The Greek **agape** ( $\dot{\alpha}\gamma\dot{\alpha}\pi\eta$ ) denotes self-sacrificial, unconditional love—the highest form of love, characterizing God's nature (1 John 4:8) and the love Christians are called to demonstrate.

#### **Messiah** — Χριστός (Christos)

Christ, Anointed One

The Greek **Christos** (Χριστός) translates 'Messiah'—the Anointed One. Peter confessed 'Thou art the Christ, the Son of the living God' (Matthew 16:16), recognizing Jesus as the long-awaited Messiah.

### **Word** — λόγος (Logos)

Word, reason, message

The Greek **Logos** (Λόγος) means word, reason, or message—the rational principle underlying reality. John identifies Christ as the eternal Logos: 'In the beginning was the Word' (John 1:1).

# **Wrath** — ὀργή (Orgē)

Wrath, anger

The Greek  $org\bar{e}$  (opyh) means wrath—settled, righteous anger against sin. Believers are 'saved from wrath through him' (Romans 5:9), as Christ bore God's wrath on the cross, satisfying divine justice.
