

# Deuteronomy 11:19

Authorized King James Version (KJV)

And ye shall teach them your children, speaking of them when thou sittest in thine house, and when thou walkest by the way, when thou liest down, and when thou risest up.

## Analysis

The command extends to generational transmission: 'teach them your children, speaking of them' whenever—'when thou sittest in thine house, when thou walkest by the way, when thou liest down, and when thou risest up.' This describes total life integration—Scripture discussion permeates all contexts: home, travel, morning, evening. The Hebrew *diber* (דָּבֵר, 'speak, talk') indicates conversational teaching, not just formal instruction. Faith transmission requires consistent, natural Scripture engagement throughout daily life. Parents bear primary responsibility for children's spiritual formation.

## Historical Context

This repeats Deuteronomy 6:7, establishing home-centered spiritual education. Ancient Israel lacked synagogue schools until post-exilic period; fathers taught children Torah. The Shema and surrounding commandments formed core curriculum. This domestic discipleship model contrasts with modern delegation of spiritual training to church programs. Family discipleship was covenant requirement, not optional.
