The Folly of Fools

- ¹ Dead flies cause the ointment of the apothecary to send forth a stinking savour: so doth a little folly him that is in reputation for wisdom and honour.
- ² A wise man's heart is at his right hand; but a fool's heart at his left.
- ³ Yea also, when he that is a fool walketh by the way, his wisdom faileth him, and he saith to every one that he is a fool.
- ⁴ If the spirit of the ruler rise up against thee, leave not thy place; for yielding pacifieth great offences.
- ⁵ There is an evil which I have seen under the sun, as an error which proceedeth from the ruler:
- ⁶ Folly is set in great dignity, and the rich sit in low place.
- $^{7}\,$ I have seen servants upon horses, and princes walking as servants upon the earth.
- ⁸ He that diggeth a pit shall fall into it; and whoso breaketh an hedge, a serpent shall bite him.
- ⁹ Whoso removeth stones shall be hurt therewith; and he that cleaveth wood shall be endangered thereby.
- ¹⁰ If the iron be blunt, and he do not whet the edge, then must he put to more strength: but wisdom is profitable to direct.
- ¹¹ Surely the serpent will bite without enchantment; and a babbler is no better.
- 12 The words of a wise man's mouth are gracious; but the lips of a fool will swallow up himself.

Ecclesiastes 10

13 The beginning of the words of his mouth is foolishness: and the end of his talk is

mischievous madness.

¹⁴ A fool also is full of words: a man cannot tell what shall be; and what shall be

after him, who can tell him?

¹⁵ The labour of the foolish wearieth every one of them, because he knoweth not

how to go to the city.

¹⁶ Woe to thee, O land, when thy king is a child, and thy princes eat in the morning!

¹⁷ Blessed art thou, O land, when thy king is the son of nobles, and thy princes eat

in due season, for strength, and not for drunkenness!

¹⁸ By much slothfulness the building decayeth; and through idleness of the hands

the house droppeth through.

¹⁹ A feast is made for laughter, and wine maketh merry: but money answereth all

things.

²⁰ Curse not the king, no not in thy thought; and curse not the rich in thy

bedchamber: for a bird of the air shall carry the voice, and that which hath wings

shall tell the matter.

Spirit — רוּחַ (Ruach)

Spirit, wind, breath

The Hebrew **ruach** (רוֹחַ) means spirit, wind, or breath—invisible but powerful. It describes both the Holy Spirit and the human spirit. God's Spirit gives life and empowers His people.

Word — דָבָר (Davar)

Word, thing, matter

The Hebrew davar (דָבֶר) means word, thing, or matter—God's creative and authoritative speech. 'By the word of the LORD were the heavens

made' (Psalm 33:6).
