

Exodus 15:2

Authorized King James Version (KJV)

The LORD is my strength and song, and he is become my salvation: he is my God, and I will prepare him an habitation; my father's God, and I will exalt him.

Analysis

The declaration 'The LORD is my strength and song' makes God both the power for victory and the subject of praise. The phrase 'he is become my salvation' uses 'yeshuah' (הַשְׁעָה), meaning salvation/deliverance—root of Jesus' name. The personal pronouns shift from 'the LORD' (third person) to 'my God' (first person), showing intimate relationship. The resolve 'I will prepare him an habitation' anticipates the tabernacle. The phrase 'my father's God' connects present experience to patriarchal covenant.

Historical Context

This verse's promise to build God a dwelling would be fulfilled in chapters 25-40 with the tabernacle construction. It shows that experiencing salvation leads to desiring God's presence.
