

Exodus 34:9

Authorized King James Version (KJV)

And he said, If now I have found grace in thy sight, O Lord, let my Lord, I pray thee, go among us; for it is a stiffnecked people; and pardon our iniquity and our sin, and take us for thine inheritance.

Analysis

Moses intercedes based on God's revealed character, citing the divine attributes just proclaimed. He acknowledges Israel's 'stiffnecked' (קָשָׁה-עֲרָפָה, qesheh-oreph) nature—stubborn as oxen resisting the yoke—yet appeals for pardon (חַלְצָה, salach) and inheritance (נָחָלָה, nachal). Moses asks God to 'go among us' despite their sin, trusting mercy over judgment. His prayer models intercession grounded in God's own promises and character.

Historical Context

God had previously threatened to send an angel rather than go personally among Israel (33:2-3). Moses here requests full restoration of divine presence.
