

# Exodus 39:28

Authorized King James Version (KJV)

And a mitre of fine linen, and goodly bonnets of fine linen, and linen breeches of fine twined linen,

## Analysis

---

The mitre (מִצְנֶפֶת, mitsnefet, turban) for Aaron, bonnets (מִגְבָּאוֹת, migba'ot, caps) for his sons, and linen breeches (מִכְנֶסֶי־בָד, michnesei-vad) for modesty complete the priestly wardrobe. The head coverings distinguish office (Aaron's elaborate mitre vs. sons' simpler caps) while the linen breeches ensure modesty in God's presence (Exodus 28:42-43). The emphasis on covering (head to loins) teaches that approaching God requires complete, proper attire—not casual or careless. Christ, perfectly clothed in righteousness, grants believers proper covering for divine presence.

## Historical Context

---

The linen breeches, worn underneath outer garments, prevented any exposure during ministry, especially when ascending altar steps. This modesty requirement (contrast with pagan worship's sometimes lewd practices) emphasized YHWH's holiness and the reverence due Him. The priests' complete covering, head to loins, visually communicated holiness.
