And seven days of the feast he shall prepare a burnt offering to the LORD, seven bullocks and seven rams without blemish daily the seven days; and a kid of the goats daily for a sin offering.

Analysis

And seven days of the feast he shall prepare a burnt offering to the LORD, seven bullocks and seven rams without blemish daily the seven days— During Passover week, daily offerings: שְׁבָעַת יָמִים (shiv'at yāmîm, 'seven days'), שְׁבָעָה פָּרִים וּשְׁבָעָה אַיִלִים תְּמִימִם (shiv'āh phārîm wēshiv'āh 'ēlîm tēmîmim, 'seven bulls and seven rams without blemish') לַיּוֹם (layyôm, 'daily').

The number seven (completeness/perfection) pervades: seven days, seven bulls, seven rams, repeated seven times. This extensive offering demonstrates lavish worship in millennial kingdom. **And a kid of the goats daily for a sin offering—** Plus daily שָׂעִיר-עַזִּים לְחַטָּאת (sé'îr-'izzîm lēhătṭâ'at, 'male goat for sin offering'). The abundance contrasts with wilderness scarcity, showing that prosperity enables greater worship—a principle fulfilled when believers offer themselves as living sacrifices (Romans 12:1).

Historical Context

Mosaic Passover offerings (Numbers 28:19-24) included bulls, rams, and lambs, but quantities differ from Ezekiel's vision. This innovation demonstrates that millennial worship, while rooted in Mosaic patterns, surpasses it in abundance—

fulfilling Jesus' promise of abundant life (John 10:10). The multiplication of offerings reflects increased capacity to honor God when His kingdom fully comes.
