# Galatians 5

Chapter 5 of 6 · 26 Verses · Authorized King James Version

#### **Christ Has Set Us Free**

- <sup>1</sup> Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage.
- <sup>2</sup> Behold, I Paul say unto you, that if ye be circumcised, Christ shall profit you nothing.
- <sup>3</sup> For I testify again to every man that is circumcised, that he is a debtor to do the whole law.
- <sup>4</sup> Christ is become of no effect unto you, whosoever of you are justified by the law; ye are fallen from grace.
- <sup>5</sup> For we through the Spirit wait for the hope of righteousness by faith.
- <sup>6</sup> For in Jesus Christ neither circumcision availeth any thing, nor uncircumcision; but faith which worketh by love.
- $^{7}$  Ye did run well; who did hinder you that ye should not obey the truth?
- $^{8}$  This persuasion cometh not of him that calleth you.
- <sup>9</sup> A little leaven leaveneth the whole lump.
- <sup>10</sup> I have confidence in you through the Lord, that ye will be none otherwise minded: but he that troubleth you shall bear his judgment, whosoever he be.
- <sup>11</sup> And I, brethren, if I yet preach circumcision, why do I yet suffer persecution? then is the offence of the cross ceased.
- <sup>12</sup> I would they were even cut off which trouble you.

#### Freedom in Christ

- For, brethren, ye have been called unto liberty; only use not liberty for an occasion to the flesh, but by love serve one another.
- <sup>14</sup> For all the law is fulfilled in one word, even in this; Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.
- <sup>15</sup> But if ye bite and devour one another, take heed that ye be not consumed one of another.

## Walking by the Spirit

- <sup>16</sup> This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh.
- <sup>17</sup> For the flesh lusteth against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh: and these are contrary the one to the other: so that ye cannot do the things that ye would.
- <sup>18</sup> But if ye be led of the Spirit, ye are not under the law.
- <sup>19</sup> Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are these; Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness,
- <sup>20</sup> Idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies,
- <sup>21</sup> Envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings, and such like: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told you in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God.
- <sup>22</sup> But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith,
- <sup>23</sup> Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law.
- <sup>24</sup> And they that are Christ's have crucified the flesh with the affections and lusts.
- <sup>25</sup> If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit.

<sup>26</sup> Let us not be desirous of vain glory, provoking one another, envying one another.

#### **HEBREW & GREEK WORD STUDIES**

## **Faith** — πίστις (Pistis)

Faith, belief, trust

The Greek **pistis** ( $\pi$ i $\sigma$ t $\tau$ g) denotes faith, belief, or trust—confidence in God's character and promises. It's both intellectual assent and relational trust, central to justification (Romans 5:1).

## **God** — Θεός (Theos)

God

The Greek **Theos** ( $\Theta \epsilon \acute{o} \varsigma$ ) refers to deity, used both for the one true God and false gods. Context determines whether it denotes the Father specifically or the Godhead generally.

# **Grace** — χάρις (Charis)

Grace, favor

The Greek **charis** (χάρις) denotes unmerited divine favor—God's kindness toward the undeserving. Salvation is 'by grace through faith' (Ephesians 2:8), not human merit.

## **Kingdom** — βασιλεία (Basileia)

Kingdom, reign

The Greek **basileia** ( $\beta\alpha\sigma\iota\lambda\epsilon(\alpha)$  means kingdom—both the realm ruled and the exercise of royal authority. The 'kingdom of God' is central to Jesus' teaching, representing God's saving rule breaking into history.

## Law — νόμος (Nomos)

Law

The Greek **nomos** ( $\nu$ ó $\mu$ o $\varsigma$ ) denotes law—particularly the Mosaic law. While believers are not under law but under grace (Romans 6:14), Christ fulfilled the law (Matthew 5:17) and wrote it on believers' hearts (Hebrews 8:10).

## **Lord** — Κύριος (Kurios)

Lord, Master

The Greek **Kurios** (Κύριος) means 'lord' or 'master,' used both for human masters and divinely for God the Father and Jesus Christ. Its application to Jesus affirms His deity, as it translates YHWH in the Septuagint.

## **Love** — ἀγάπη (Agape)

Divine love

The Greek **agape** ( $\dot{\alpha}\gamma\dot{\alpha}\pi\eta$ ) denotes self-sacrificial, unconditional love—the highest form of love, characterizing God's nature (1 John 4:8) and the love Christians are called to demonstrate.

#### Spirit — πνεῦμα (Pneuma)

Spirit, wind, breath

The Greek **pneuma** ( $\pi\nu\epsilon\tilde{\nu}\mu\alpha$ ) means spirit, wind, or breath—the immaterial aspect of persons. The Holy Spirit (Pneuma Hagion) is the third person of the Trinity, dwelling in believers.

**Truth** — ἀλήθεια (Aletheia)

Truth, reality

The Greek **aletheia** (ἀλήθεια) denotes truth or reality—that which corresponds to actuality. Jesus declared, 'I am the way, the truth, and the life' (John 14:6), embodying ultimate reality.

Word — λόγος (Logos)

Word, reason, message

The Greek **Logos** (Λόγος) means word, reason, or message—the rational principle underlying reality. John identifies Christ as the eternal Logos: 'In the beginning was the Word' (John 1:1).
