

Hebrews 3:5

Authorized King James Version (KJV)

And Moses verily was faithful in all his house, as a servant, for a testimony of those things which were to be spoken after;

Analysis

Moses' role as 'therapon' (servant/attendant) emphasizes his faithful ministry while clearly subordinating him to Christ. His testimony was 'of those things which were to be spoken after'—he pointed forward to Christ. The entire Mosaic economy was anticipatory, typological, and temporary, serving as a tutor leading to Christ (Galatians 3:24).

Historical Context

Moses himself prophesied the coming of a greater prophet (Deuteronomy 18:15-18), recognized in Jewish tradition as the Messiah. Moses' own testimony thus validated Christ's supremacy.

Additional Cross-References

Numbers 12:7 (Faith): My servant Moses is not so, who is faithful in all mine house.

Hebrews 3:2 (Faith): Who was faithful to him that appointed him, as also Moses was faithful in all his house.

Exodus 14:31 (Faith): And Israel saw that great work which the LORD did upon the Egyptians: and the people feared the LORD, and believed the LORD, and his servant Moses.

Psalms 105:26 (References Moses): He sent Moses his servant; and Aaron whom he had chosen.

Deuteronomy 34:5 (References Moses): So Moses the servant of the LORD died there in the land of Moab, according to the word of the LORD.

Joshua 1:2 (References Moses): Moses my servant is dead; now therefore arise, go over this Jordan, thou, and all this people, unto the land which I do give to them, even to the children of Israel.

Hebrews 9:24 (Parallel theme): For Christ is not entered into the holy places made with hands, which are the figures of the true; but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God for us:
