And we desire that every one of you do shew the same diligence to the full assurance of hope unto the end:

Analysis

'We desire' expresses pastoral concern that each believer show 'the same diligence' not just initially but 'to the full assurance of hope unto the end.' 'Full assurance' (Greek 'plerophoria') means complete confidence and certainty. Enduring hope evidences genuine faith. The contrast is between initial enthusiasm and long-term perseverance—the latter demonstrates reality.

Historical Context

The warning against sloth (Greek 'nothroi'—sluggish, lazy) suggests some were becoming spiritually complacent. Perseverance requires diligent cultivation of hope through continued trust in God's promises.

Additional Cross-References

Hebrews 3:6 (Hope): But Christ as a son over his own house; whose house are we, if we hold fast the confidence and the rejoicing of the hope firm unto the end.

Hebrews 3:14 (Parallel theme): For we are made partakers of Christ, if we hold the beginning of our confidence stedfast unto the end;

1 Peter 1:21 (Hope): Who by him do believe in God, that raised him up from the dead, and gave him glory; that your faith and hope might be in God.

2 Thessalonians 3:13 (Parallel theme): But ye, brethren, be not weary in well doing.
