

# Isaiah 42:11

Authorized King James Version (KJV)

Let the wilderness and the cities thereof lift up their voice, the villages that Kedar doth inhabit: let the inhabitants of the rock sing, let them shout from the top of the mountains.

## Analysis

The call to praise extends to wilderness and its cities, villages of Kedar (Bedouin settlements), and inhabitants of Sela (rock dwellers). Even traditionally hostile or remote peoples will sing from mountaintops. No place or people are beyond God's redemptive reach.

## Historical Context

Kedar (descendants of Ishmael) and Sela (Edomite region) represent traditional enemies of Israel. Their inclusion in worship demonstrates that salvation transcends ethnic and historical enmity through God's reconciling work.
