

Isaiah 45:14

Authorized King James Version (KJV)

Thus saith the LORD, The labour of Egypt, and merchandise of Ethiopia and of the Sabeans, men of stature, shall come over unto thee, and they shall be thine: they shall come after thee; in chains they shall come over, and they shall fall down unto thee, they shall make supplication unto thee, saying, Surely God is in thee; and there is none else, there is no God.

Analysis

God announces that wealth from Egypt, Ethiopia, and the Sabeans will come to Israel, acknowledging 'Surely God is in thee; and there is none else, there is no God.' The tall Sabeans (known for height) will come in chains and bow down. Nations will recognize that Israel's God alone is God.

Historical Context

This looks beyond immediate return to messianic fulfillment when Gentile nations bring their wealth and worship to Zion. This finds partial fulfillment in Solomon's era and fuller in the church's expansion.

Isaiah 49:23 (References Lord): And kings shall be thy nursing fathers, and their queens thy nursing mothers: they shall bow down to thee with their face toward the earth, and lick up the dust of thy feet; and thou shalt know that I am the LORD: for they shall not be ashamed that wait for me.

Isaiah 23:18 (References Lord): And her merchandise and her hire shall be holiness to the LORD: it shall not be treasured nor laid up; for her merchandise shall be for them that dwell before the LORD, to eat sufficiently, and for durable clothing.

Isaiah 61:9 (References Lord): And their seed shall be known among the Gentiles, and their offspring among the people: all that see them shall acknowledge them, that they are the seed which the LORD hath blessed.

Isaiah 43:3 (References God): For I am the LORD thy God, the Holy One of Israel, thy Saviour: I gave Egypt for thy ransom, Ethiopia and Seba for thee.

Isaiah 18:7 (References Lord): In that time shall the present be brought unto the LORD of hosts of a people scattered and peeled, and from a people terrible from

their beginning hitherto; a nation meted out and trodden under foot, whose land the rivers have spoiled, to the place of the name of the LORD of hosts, the mount Zion.
