

Isaiah 48:17

Authorized King James Version (KJV)

Thus saith the LORD, thy Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel; I am the LORD thy God which teacheth thee to profit, which leadeth thee by the way that thou shouldest go.

Analysis

The titles 'thy Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel' combine salvation and sanctification, showing that redemption from sin's penalty includes transformation of character. The description 'which teacheth thee to profit' and 'leadeth thee by the way' depicts God as both instructor and guide. True gospel includes not just forgiveness but discipleship - God redeems to transform.

Historical Context

This teaching role anticipates Jesus as Rabbi who instructs disciples and Spirit who leads into all truth (John 16:13). The 'way that thou shouldest go' echoes Psalm 32:8 and prefigures Jesus as 'the Way' (John 14:6).

Additional Cross-References

Psalms 32:8 (Parallel theme): I will instruct thee and teach thee in the way which thou shalt go: I will guide thee with mine eye.

Psalms 25:12 (References Lord): What man is he that feareth the LORD? him shall he teach in the way that he shall choose.

Jeremiah 6:16 (References Lord): Thus saith the LORD, Stand ye in the ways, and see, and ask for the old paths, where is the good way, and walk therein, and ye shall find rest for your souls. But they said, We will not walk therein.
