

Jeremiah 27:5

Authorized King James Version (KJV)

I have made the earth, the man and the beast that are upon the ground, by my great power and by my outstretched arm, and have given it unto whom it seemed meet unto me.

Analysis

This verse grounds God's sovereignty in His role as Creator. The phrase 'by my great power and by my outstretched arm' echoes Exodus language, now applied to giving kingdoms to whomever God chooses - including pagan Nebuchadnezzar. Reformed theology emphasizes God's absolute sovereignty over all nations and rulers (Dan 4:17, Rom 13:1). No human power exists independent of God's decree.

Historical Context

Jeremiah wore an actual wooden yoke as a prophetic sign, symbolizing submission to Babylon. This was scandalous - appearing to support the enemy - yet it was God's revealed will.

Additional Cross-References

Jeremiah 51:15 (Creation): He hath made the earth by his power, he hath established the world by his wisdom, and hath stretched out the heaven by his understanding.

Jeremiah 32:17 (Creation): Ah Lord GOD! behold, thou hast made the heaven and the earth by thy great power and stretched out arm, and there is nothing too hard for thee:

Daniel 4:17 (Parallel theme): This matter is by the decree of the watchers, and the demand by the word of the holy ones: to the intent that the living may know that the most High ruleth in the kingdom of men, and giveth it to whomsoever he will, and setteth up over it the basest of men.
