**Jeremiah 17:12** (Parallel theme): A glorious high throne from the beginning is the place of our sanctuary.

**Ezekiel 43:7** (Parallel theme): And he said unto me, Son of man, the place of my throne, and the place of the soles of my feet, where I will dwell in the midst of the children of Israel for ever, and my holy name, shall the house of Israel no more defile, neither they, nor their kings, by their whoredom, nor by the carcases of their kings in their high places.

**Jeremiah 11:8** (Evil): Yet they obeyed not, nor inclined their ear, but walked every one in the imagination of their evil heart: therefore I will bring upon them all the words of this covenant, which I commanded them to do; but they did them not.
