My people, go ye out of the midst of her, and deliver ye every man his soul from the fierce anger of the LORD.

Analysis

'My people, go ye out of the midst of her, and deliver ye every man his soul from the fierce anger of the LORD.' This urgent call to flee Babylon echoes 51:6 and anticipates Revelation 18:4. Separation from corrupt systems is necessary for spiritual survival. The phrase 'deliver ye every man his soul' emphasizes individual responsibility - each person must actively pursue holiness and separation from evil.

Historical Context

This command applied literally to Jews in Babylon during its fall, and spiritually to all God's people called to separate from worldly systems.

Additional Cross-References

Revelation 18:4 (Parallel theme): And I heard another voice from heaven, saying, Come out of her, my people, that ye be not partakers of her sins, and that ye receive not of her plagues.

Isaiah 48:20 (References Lord): Go ye forth of Babylon, flee ye from the Chaldeans, with a voice of singing declare ye, tell this, utter it even to the end of the earth; say ye, The LORD hath redeemed his servant Jacob.

Jeremiah 51:6 (References Lord): Flee out of the midst of Babylon, and deliver every man his soul: be not cut off in her iniquity; for this is the time of the LORD'S vengeance; he will render unto her a recompence.

Jeremiah 50:8 (Parallel theme): Remove out of the midst of Babylon, and go forth out of the land of the Chaldeans, and be as the he goats before the flocks.

Acts 2:40 (Parallel theme): And with many other words did he testify and exhort, saying, Save yourselves from this untoward generation.

Numbers 16:26 (Parallel theme): And he spake unto the congregation, saying, Depart, I pray you, from the tents of these wicked men, and touch nothing of their's, lest ye be consumed in all their sins.
