Job's Reply: Miserable Comforters Are You All

- ¹ Then Job answered and said,
- ² I have heard many such things: miserable comforters are ye all.
- ³ Shall vain words have an end? or what emboldeneth thee that thou answerest?
- ⁴ I also could speak as ye do: if your soul were in my soul's stead, I could heap up words against you, and shake mine head at you.
- ⁵ But I would strengthen you with my mouth, and the moving of my lips should asswage your grief.
- ⁶ Though I speak, my grief is not asswaged: and though I forbear, what am I eased?
- 7 But now he hath made me weary: thou hast made desolate all my company.
- ⁸ And thou hast filled me with wrinkles, which is a witness against me: and my leanness rising up in me beareth witness to my face.
- ⁹ He teareth me in his wrath, who hateth me: he gnasheth upon me with his teeth; mine enemy sharpeneth his eyes upon me.
- ¹⁰ They have gaped upon me with their mouth; they have smitten me upon the cheek reproachfully; they have gathered themselves together against me.
- ¹¹ God hath delivered me to the ungodly, and turned me over into the hands of the wicked.

- ¹² I was at ease, but he hath broken me asunder: he hath also taken me by my neck, and shaken me to pieces, and set me up for his mark.
- His archers compass me round about, he cleaveth my reins asunder, and doth not spare; he poureth out my gall upon the ground.
- 14 He breaketh me with breach upon breach, he runneth upon me like a giant.
- 15 I have sewed sackcloth upon my skin, and defiled my horn in the dust.
- ¹⁶ My face is foul with weeping, and on my eyelids is the shadow of death;
- ¹⁷ Not for any injustice in mine hands: also my prayer is pure.

My Witness Is in Heaven

- ¹⁸ O earth, cover not thou my blood, and let my cry have no place.
- ¹⁹ Also now, behold, my witness is in heaven, and my record is on high.
- ²⁰ My friends scorn me: but mine eye poureth out tears unto God.
- ²¹ O that one might plead for a man with God, as a man pleadeth for his neighbour!
- ²² When a few years are come, then I shall go the way whence I shall not return.

HEBREW & GREEK WORD STUDIES

Blood — pr (Dam)

Blood

The Hebrew dam (DI) means blood—representing life itself. 'The life of the flesh is in the blood' (Leviticus 17:11), and blood was required for atonement, foreshadowing Christ's sacrifice.

God — אֵלהִים (Elohim)

God (plural of majesty)

The Hebrew **Elohim** (אֱלֹהִים) is a plural form denoting majesty and fullness of deity. Though grammatically plural, it takes singular verbs when referring to the one true God, suggesting the Trinity's plurality within unity.

Heaven — שָׁמֵים (Shamayim)

Heaven, sky

The Hebrew **shamayim** (שְׁמֵּיִם) means heaven or sky—God's dwelling place and the realm above earth. 'The heaven, even the heavens, are the LORD's' (Psalm 115:16), yet 'the heaven of heavens cannot contain Him' (1 Kings 8:27).

Wrath — אַף (Aph)

Wrath, anger

The Hebrew **aph** (אַא) literally means 'nose' or 'nostrils,' idiomatically expressing wrath or anger —God's righteous indignation against sin. Yet God is 'slow to anger' (Exodus 34:6) and 'abundant in mercy.'

Word — דַבַר (Davar)

Word, thing, matter

The Hebrew **davar** (FCr) means word, thing, or matter—God's creative and authoritative speech. 'By the word of the LORD were the heavens made' (Psalm 33:6).
