Job Continues: My Spirit Is Broken

- ¹ My breath is corrupt, my days are extinct, the graves are ready for me.

HEBREW & GREEK WORD STUDIES

Hope — תָקוַה (Tikvah)

Hope, expectation

The Hebrew **tikvah** (תַּקוָה) means hope or expectation—confident trust in God's promises. 'Happy is he that hath the God of Jacob for his help, whose hope is in the LORD his God' (Psalm 146:5).

Righteous — צַדִּיק (Tzaddik)

Righteous one

The Hebrew **tzaddik** (צַּדִּיק) describes one who is righteous, just, or lawful—conforming to God's standard. From the root tzedek (צָּדָק), meaning righteousness or justice.
