# Job's Final Defense: My Life in the Past

- <sup>1</sup> Moreover Job continued his parable, and said,
- <sup>2</sup> Oh that I were as in months past, as in the days when God preserved me;
- <sup>3</sup> When his candle shined upon my head, and when by his light I walked through darkness;
- <sup>4</sup> As I was in the days of my youth, when the secret of God was upon my tabernacle;
- <sup>5</sup> When the Almighty was yet with me, when my children were about me;
- <sup>6</sup> When I washed my steps with butter, and the rock poured me out rivers of oil;
- <sup>7</sup> When I went out to the gate through the city, when I prepared my seat in the street!
- <sup>8</sup> The young men saw me, and hid themselves: and the aged arose, and stood up.
- <sup>9</sup> The princes refrained talking, and laid their hand on their mouth.
- $^{10}$  The nobles held their peace, and their tongue cleaved to the roof of their mouth.
- When the ear heard me, then it blessed me; and when the eye saw me, it gave witness to me:
- $^{12}$  Because I delivered the poor that cried, and the fatherless, and him that had none to help him.

- $^{13}$  The blessing of him that was ready to perish came upon me: and I caused the widow's heart to sing for joy.
- 14 I put on righteousness, and it clothed me: my judgment was as a robe and a diadem.
- $^{15}$  I was eyes to the blind, and feet was I to the lame.
- $^{16}$  I was a father to the poor: and the cause which I knew not I searched out.
- $^{17}$  And I brake the jaws of the wicked, and plucked the spoil out of his teeth.
- <sup>18</sup> Then I said, I shall die in my nest, and I shall multiply my days as the sand.
- $^{19}$  My root was spread out by the waters, and the dew lay all night upon my branch.
- <sup>20</sup> My glory was fresh in me, and my bow was renewed in my hand.
- <sup>21</sup> Unto me men gave ear, and waited, and kept silence at my counsel.
- <sup>22</sup> After my words they spake not again; and my speech dropped upon them.
- <sup>23</sup> And they waited for me as for the rain; and they opened their mouth wide as for the latter rain.
- If I laughed on them, they believed it not; and the light of my countenance they cast not down.
- <sup>25</sup> I chose out their way, and sat chief, and dwelt as a king in the army, as one that comforteth the mourners.

#### **HEBREW & GREEK WORD STUDIES**

# **Believe** — אָמַן (Aman)

To believe, trust, be faithful

The Hebrew **aman** (אָמַן) means to believe or confirm—the root of 'Amen.' It conveys firm trust and reliability. Abraham 'believed in the LORD; and he counted it to him for righteousness' (Genesis 15:6).

# (Kavod) כַּבוֹד (Kavod

Glory, weight, honor

The Hebrew **kavod** (קבוֹד) literally means 'weight' or 'heaviness,' metaphorically denoting glory, honor, or majesty. God's glory (Shekinah) filled the tabernacle (Exodus 40:34) and temple (1 Kings 8:11).

# God — אַלהִים (Elohim)

God (plural of majesty)

The Hebrew **Elohim** (אֶלהִים) is a plural form denoting majesty and fullness of deity. Though grammatically plural, it takes singular verbs when referring to the one true God, suggesting the Trinity's plurality within unity.

#### Judgment — מִשְׁפַט (Mishpat)

Judgment, justice

The Hebrew **mishpat** (מִשְׁפֵּט) means judgment or justice—God's righteous decisions and ordinances. God is the Judge of all the earth who 'shall do right' (Genesis 18:25), executing perfect justice.

#### Righteous — צַדִּיק (Tzaddik)

Righteous one

The Hebrew **tzaddik** (צַדִּיק) describes one who is righteous, just, or lawful—conforming to God's standard. From the root tzedek (צֶּדֶק), meaning righteousness or justice.

# Word — דָבַר (Davar)

Word, thing, matter

The Hebrew **davar** (דְּבֶּר) means word, thing, or matter—God's creative and authoritative speech. 'By the word of the LORD were the heavens made' (Psalm 33:6).
