Authorized King James Version (KJV)

If there be a messenger with him, an interpreter, one among a thousand, to shew unto man his uprightness:

## Analysis

---

Elihu speaks of mediators: 'If there be a messenger with him, an interpreter, one among a thousand, to shew unto man his uprightness.' This acknowledges need for divine-human mediation. Elihu presents himself as such interpreter, anticipating Christ as ultimate mediator.

## Historical Context

---

Ancient Near Eastern wisdom featured intermediary figures. Elihu's 'one among a thousand' suggests rarity of true mediators.

**Malachi 3:1** (Parallel theme): Behold, I will send my messenger, and he shall prepare the way before me: and the Lord, whom ye seek, shall suddenly come to his temple, even the messenger of the covenant, whom ye delight in: behold, he shall come, saith the LORD of hosts.

**Ecclesiastes 7:28** (Parallel theme): Which yet my soul seeketh, but I find not: one man among a thousand have I found; but a woman among all those have I not found.

**Psalms 119:75** (Parallel theme): I know, O LORD, that thy judgments are right, and that thou in faithfulness hast afflicted me.

**Job 37:23** (Parallel theme): Touching the Almighty, we cannot find him out: he is excellent in power, and in judgment, and in plenty of justice: he will not afflict.

**Job 36:3** (Parallel theme): I will fetch my knowledge from afar, and will ascribe righteousness to my Maker.

**Lamentations 3:32** (Parallel theme): But though he cause grief, yet will he have compassion according to the multitude of his mercies.
