God Continues: Can You Control the Animals?

- ¹ Knowest thou the time when the wild goats of the rock bring forth? or canst thou mark when the hinds do calve?
- ² Canst thou number the months that they fulfil? or knowest thou the time when they bring forth?
- ³ They bow themselves, they bring forth their young ones, they cast out their sorrows.
- ⁴ Their young ones are in good liking, they grow up with corn; they go forth, and return not unto them.
- ⁵ Who hath sent out the wild ass free? or who hath loosed the bands of the wild ass?
- ⁶ Whose house I have made the wilderness, and the barren land his dwellings.
- 7 He scorneth the multitude of the city, neither regardeth he the crying of the driver.
- ⁸ The range of the mountains is his pasture, and he searcheth after every green thing.
- 9 Will the unicorn be willing to serve thee, or abide by thy crib?
- Canst thou bind the unicorn with his band in the furrow? or will he harrow the valleys after thee?
- Wilt thou trust him, because his strength is great? or wilt thou leave thy labour to him?

- ²¹ He paweth in the valley, and rejoiceth in his strength: he goeth on to meet the armed men.
- ²² He mocketh at fear, and is not affrighted; neither turneth he back from the sword.
- 23 The quiver rattleth against him, the glittering spear and the shield.
- 24 He swalloweth the ground with fierceness and rage: neither believeth he that it is the sound of the trumpet.

HEBREW & GREEK WORD STUDIES

Believe — אָמַן (Aman)

To believe, trust, be faithful

The Hebrew **aman** (אָמַן) means to believe or confirm—the root of 'Amen.' It conveys firm trust and reliability. Abraham 'believed in the LORD; and he counted it to him for righteousness' (Genesis 15:6).

Blood — DI (Dam)

Blood

The Hebrew dam (nī) means blood—representing life itself. 'The life of the flesh is in the blood' (Leviticus 17:11), and blood was required for atonement, foreshadowing Christ's sacrifice.

God — אֱלֹהִים (Elohim)

God (plural of majesty)

The Hebrew **Elohim** (אֱלֹהִים) is a plural form denoting majesty and fullness of deity. Though grammatically plural, it takes singular verbs when referring to the one true God, suggesting the Trinity's plurality within unity.

Repent — שוב / נַחַם (Shuv / Nacham)

To turn back, relent

The Hebrew **shuv** (שוב) means to turn or return—a physical turning that represents spiritual redirection back to God. **Nacham** (בַּחַם) conveys grief or relenting, often used of God 'repenting' of judgment.
