Bildad's First Speech: God Is Just

- ¹ Then answered Bildad the Shuhite, and said,
- ² How long wilt thou speak these things? and how long shall the words of thy mouth be like a strong wind?
- ³ Doth God pervert judgment? or doth the Almighty pervert justice?
- ⁴ If thy children have sinned against him, and he have cast them away for their transgression;
- If thou wouldest seek unto God betimes, and make thy supplication to the Almighty;
- ⁶ If thou wert pure and upright; surely now he would awake for thee, and make the habitation of thy righteousness prosperous.
- 7 Though thy beginning was small, yet thy latter end should greatly increase.
- ⁸ For enquire, I pray thee, of the former age, and prepare thyself to the search of their fathers:
- ⁹ (For we are but of yesterday, and know nothing, because our days upon earth are a shadow:)
- 10 Shall not they teach thee, and tell thee, and utter words out of their heart?
- ¹¹ Can the rush grow up without mire? can the flag grow without water?

- Whilst it is yet in his greenness, and not cut down, it withereth before any other herb.
- 13 So are the paths of all that forget God; and the hypocrite's hope shall perish:
- ¹⁴ Whose hope shall be cut off, and whose trust shall be a spider's web.
- ¹⁵ He shall lean upon his house, but it shall not stand: he shall hold it fast, but it shall not endure.
- ¹⁶ He is green before the sun, and his branch shooteth forth in his garden.
- ¹⁷ His roots are wrapped about the heap, and seeth the place of stones.
- ¹⁸ If he destroy him from his place, then it shall deny him, saying, I have not seen thee.
- ¹⁹ Behold, this is the joy of his way, and out of the earth shall others grow.
- 20 Behold, God will not cast away a perfect man, neither will he help the evil doers:
- ²¹ Till he fill thy mouth with laughing, and thy lips with rejoicing.
- ²² They that hate thee shall be clothed with shame; and the dwelling place of the wicked shall come to nought.

HEBREW & GREEK WORD STUDIES

God — אֱלֹהִים (Elohim)

God (plural of majesty)

The Hebrew **Elohim** (אֱלֹהִים) is a plural form denoting majesty and fullness of deity. Though grammatically plural, it takes singular verbs when referring to the one true God, suggesting the Trinity's plurality within unity.

Hope — תָקוַה (Tikvah)

Hope, expectation

The Hebrew **tikvah** (תַּקְוָה) means hope or expectation—confident trust in God's promises. 'Happy is he that hath the God of Jacob for his help, whose hope is in the LORD his God' (Psalm 146:5).

Judgment — מִשְׁפַט (Mishpat)

Judgment, justice

The Hebrew **mishpat** (מִשְּׁפֵט) means judgment or justice—God's righteous decisions and ordinances. God is the Judge of all the earth who 'shall do right' (Genesis 18:25), executing perfect justice.

Righteous — צַדִּיק (Tzaddik)

Righteous one

The Hebrew **tzaddik** (צַּדִיק) describes one who is righteous, just, or lawful—conforming to God's standard. From the root tzedek (צֶּדֶק), meaning righteousness or justice.

Spirit — חַהַ (Ruach)

Spirit, wind, breath

The Hebrew **ruach** (רוֹחַ) means spirit, wind, or breath—invisible but powerful. It describes both the Holy Spirit and the human spirit. God's Spirit gives life and empowers His people.

Transgression — פָּשַׁע (Pesha)

Transgression, rebellion

The Hebrew **pesha** (פָשַׁע) means transgression or rebellion—willful violation of God's law. It implies deliberate revolt against divine authority: 'he was wounded for our transgressions' (Isaiah 53:5).
