# John 15

Chapter 15 of 21 · 27 Verses · Authorized King James Version

## I Am the True Vine

- <sup>1</sup> I am the true vine, and my Father is the husbandman.
- <sup>2</sup> Every branch in me that beareth not fruit he taketh away: and every branch that beareth fruit, he purgeth it, that it may bring forth more fruit.
- <sup>3</sup> Now ye are clean through the word which I have spoken unto you.
- <sup>4</sup> Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the vine; no more can ye, except ye abide in me.
- <sup>5</sup> I am the vine, ye are the branches: He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without me ye can do nothing.
- <sup>6</sup> If a man abide not in me, he is cast forth as a branch, and is withered; and men gather them, and cast them into the fire, and they are burned.
- $^{7}$  If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you.
- <sup>8</sup> Herein is my Father glorified, that ye bear much fruit; so shall ye be my disciples.

# Abide in My Love

- $^{9}$  As the Father hath loved me, so have I loved you: continue ye in my love.
- $^{10}$  If ye keep my commandments, ye shall abide in my love; even as I have kept my Father's commandments, and abide in his love.
- <sup>11</sup> These things have I spoken unto you, that my joy might remain in you, and that your joy might be full.

- <sup>12</sup> This is my commandment, That ye love one another, as I have loved you.
- <sup>13</sup> Greater love hath no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends.
- <sup>14</sup> Ye are my friends, if ye do whatsoever I command you.
- <sup>15</sup> Henceforth I call you not servants; for the servant knoweth not what his lord doeth: but I have called you friends; for all things that I have heard of my Father I have made known unto you.
- <sup>16</sup> Ye have not chosen me, but I have chosen you, and ordained you, that ye should go and bring forth fruit, and that your fruit should remain: that whatsoever ye shall ask of the Father in my name, he may give it you.
- <sup>17</sup> These things I command you, that ye love one another.

#### The World's Hatred

- <sup>18</sup> If the world hate you, ye know that it hated me before it hated you.
- <sup>19</sup> If ye were of the world, the world would love his own: but because ye are not of the world, but I have chosen you out of the world, therefore the world hateth you.
- $^{20}$  Remember the word that I said unto you, The servant is not greater than his lord. If they have persecuted me, they will also persecute you; if they have kept my saying, they will keep your's also.
- <sup>21</sup> But all these things will they do unto you for my name's sake, because they know not him that sent me.
- <sup>22</sup> If I had not come and spoken unto them, they had not had sin: but now they have no cloke for their sin.
- $^{23}$  He that hateth me hateth my Father also.
- <sup>24</sup> If I had not done among them the works which none other man did, they had not had sin: but now have they both seen and hated both me and my Father.
- $^{25}$  But this cometh to pass, that the word might be fulfilled that is written in their law, They hated me without a cause.

<sup>26</sup> But when the Comforter is come, whom I will send unto you from the Father, even the Spirit of truth, which proceedeth from the Father, he shall testify of me:

<sup>27</sup> And ye also shall bear witness, because ye have been with me from the beginning.

### **HEBREW & GREEK WORD STUDIES**

## **Elect** — ἐκλεκτός (Eklektos)

#### Elect, chosen

The Greek **eklektos** (ἐκλεκτός) means chosen or elect—those selected by God. Believers are 'elect according to the foreknowledge of God the Father' (1 Peter 1:2).

### **Law** — νόμος (Nomos)

#### Law

The Greek **nomos** ( $\nu$ ó $\mu$ o $\varsigma$ ) denotes law—particularly the Mosaic law. While believers are not under law but under grace (Romans 6:14), Christ fulfilled the law (Matthew 5:17) and wrote it on believers' hearts (Hebrews 8:10).

## **Lord** — Κύριος (Kurios)

#### Lord, Master

The Greek **Kurios** (Κύριος) means 'lord' or 'master,' used both for human masters and divinely for God the Father and Jesus Christ. Its application to Jesus affirms His deity, as it translates YHWH in the Septuagint.

#### **Love** — ἀγάπη (Agape)

#### Divine love

The Greek **agape** ( $\dot{\alpha}\gamma\dot{\alpha}\pi\eta$ ) denotes self-sacrificial, unconditional love—the highest form of love, characterizing God's nature (1 John 4:8) and the love Christians are called to demonstrate.

### Sin — ἀμαρτία (Hamartia)

#### Sin, missing the mark

The Greek **hamartia** ( $\dot{\alpha}\mu\alpha\rho\tau(\alpha)$  means sin—missing the target of God's perfection. 'All have sinned and fall short of the glory of God' (Romans 3:23), requiring Christ's atoning sacrifice.

### Spirit — πνεῦμα (Pneuma)

#### Spirit, wind, breath

The Greek **pneuma** ( $\pi\nu\epsilon\tilde{\nu}\mu\alpha$ ) means spirit, wind, or breath—the immaterial aspect of persons. The Holy Spirit (Pneuma Hagion) is the third person of the Trinity, dwelling in believers.

#### **Truth** — ἀλήθεια (Aletheia)

#### Truth, reality

The Greek **aletheia** (ἀλήθεια) denotes truth or reality—that which corresponds to actuality. Jesus declared, 'I am the way, the truth, and the life' (John 14:6), embodying ultimate reality.

#### **Word** — λόγος (Logos)

#### Word, reason, message

The Greek **Logos** (Λόγος) means word, reason, or message—the rational principle underlying reality. John identifies Christ as the eternal Logos: 'In the beginning was the Word' (John 1:1).
