

# John 8:24

Authorized King James Version (KJV)

I said therefore unto you, that ye shall die in your sins: for if ye believe not that I am he, ye shall die in your sins.

## Analysis

---

Jesus states the consequence plainly: unless they believe 'that I am he,' they will die in their sins. The phrase 'I am' (ego eimi) is the divine name from Exodus 3:14, claiming deity. Belief in Christ's divine identity is not optional but necessary for salvation. This exclusivity offends modern pluralism but remains Christ's clear teaching - faith in Him alone saves.

## Historical Context

---

The use of ego eimi echoes the Septuagint's rendering of God's name to Moses, an unmistakable claim to deity that His Jewish audience would have recognized as either truth or blasphemy.

## Additional Cross-References

**John 3:36** (Faith): He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life: and he that believeth not the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abideth on him.

**John 3:18** (Faith): He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.
