Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.

Analysis

Christ's stark declaration that unbelieving Jews are 'of your father the devil' shocks modern readers but reveals spiritual paternity—children resemble their father. The devil is a 'murderer from the beginning' (referencing Cain and ultimately all death through sin) and the 'father of lies'. This establishes two families: God's children who love truth, and Satan's children who embrace lies. The harsh language shows the seriousness of rejecting Christ.

Historical Context

Jews claimed Abraham as father (v. 39); Jesus says spiritual lineage is proven by deeds, not genetics (v. 39-40). This challenged first-century Judaism's assumption that Abrahamic descent guaranteed God's favor.

Acts 13:10 (Evil): And said, O full of all subtilty and all mischief, thou child of the devil, thou enemy of all righteousness, wilt thou not cease to pervert the right ways of the Lord?

1 John 3:12 (Evil): Not as Cain, who was of that wicked one, and slew his brother. And wherefore slew he him? Because his own works were evil, and his brother's righteous.
