And she said, According unto your words, so be it. And she sent them away, and they departed: and she bound the scarlet line in the window.

## Analysis

---

Rahab's immediate compliance 'she bound the scarlet line in the window' demonstrates obedient faith. She acted immediately on instruction, maintaining visible covenant sign.

## Historical Context

---

This verse appears in the Jordan crossing narrative, one of Joshua's most significant events demonstrating God's power and faithfulness in bringing Israel into the Promised Land.
