Analysis

The spies' confident report 'Truly the LORD hath delivered into our hands all the land' demonstrates faith strengthened by witnessing God's work through Rahab.

Historical Context

This verse appears in the Jordan crossing narrative, one of Joshua's most significant events demonstrating God's power and faithfulness in bringing Israel into the Promised Land.
