Analysis

Rahab's conversation with spies before their sleep shows her testimony and covenant request. She used limited opportunity to secure her family's salvation.

Historical Context

This verse appears in the Jordan crossing narrative, one of Joshua's most significant events demonstrating God's power and faithfulness in bringing Israel into the Promised Land.

Ephesians 2:8 — Salvation by grace through faith
