

# Joshua 20:6

Authorized King James Version (KJV)

And he shall dwell in that city, until he stand before the congregation for judgment, and until the death of the high priest that shall be in those days: then shall the slayer return, and come unto his own city, and unto his own house, unto the city from whence he fled.

## Analysis

**And he shall dwell in that city, until he stand before the congregation for judgment, and until the death of the high priest that shall be in those days**  
—Two conditions for freedom:

1. trial before the congregation validates asylum
2. the high priest's death releases the manslayer. **Then shall the slayer return, and come unto his own city, and unto his own house.**

The high priest's death liberates—a profound type of Christ.

His death frees us from sin's penalty, restoring our true inheritance (Colossians 1:12-14). The manslayer cannot leave refuge until death occurs; likewise, we remain in Christ until His death's power fully manifests in our resurrection (Philippians 3:20-21).

## Historical Context

This law prevented revenge killings while acknowledging the seriousness of taking life, even accidentally. The high priest's death marked a generation's end, allowing

societal reset. Josephus notes this prevented the manslayer's indefinite exile while honoring the victim's family.
