

Joshua 3:8

Authorized King James Version (KJV)

And thou shalt command the priests that bear the ark of the covenant, saying, When ye are come to the brink of the water of Jordan, ye shall stand still in Jordan.

Analysis

The instruction for priests to 'stand still in Jordan' required faith to step into flooding river before waters parted. Obedience precedes miracle.

Historical Context

This verse appears in the Jordan crossing narrative, one of Joshua's most significant events demonstrating God's power and faithfulness in bringing Israel into the Promised Land.

Colossians 1:16 — All things created through Christ

2. What application does this truth have for your walk with Christ today?

Additional Cross-References

Joshua 3:3 (Covenant): And they commanded the people, saying, When ye see the ark of the covenant of the LORD your God, and the priests the Levites bearing it, then ye shall remove from your place, and go after it.

Joshua 3:17 (Covenant): And the priests that bare the ark of the covenant of the LORD stood firm on dry ground in the midst of Jordan, and all the Israelites passed over on dry ground, until all the people were passed clean over Jordan.
