Hope in the Lord's Faithfulness

- ¹ I am the man that hath seen affliction by the rod of his wrath.
- ² He hath led me, and brought me into darkness, but not into light.
- ³ Surely against me is he turned; he turneth his hand against me all the day.
- ⁴ My flesh and my skin hath he made old; he hath broken my bones.
- ⁵ He hath builded against me, and compassed me with gall and travail.
- ⁶ He hath set me in dark places, as they that be dead of old.
- 7 He hath hedged me about, that I cannot get out: he hath made my chain heavy.
- ⁸ Also when I cry and shout, he shutteth out my prayer.
- ⁹ He hath inclosed my ways with hewn stone, he hath made my paths crooked.
- 10 He was unto me as a bear lying in wait, and as a lion in secret places.
- ¹¹ He hath turned aside my ways, and pulled me in pieces: he hath made me desolate.
- ¹² He hath bent his bow, and set me as a mark for the arrow.
- 13 He hath caused the arrows of his quiver to enter into my reins.
- 14 I was a derision to all my people; and their song all the day.
- 15 He hath filled me with bitterness, he hath made me drunken with wormwood.
- ¹⁶ He hath also broken my teeth with gravel stones, he hath covered me with ashes.

- ¹⁷ And thou hast removed my soul far off from peace: I forgat prosperity.
- ¹⁸ And I said, My strength and my hope is perished from the LORD:
- ¹⁹ Remembering mine affliction and my misery, the wormwood and the gall.
- ²⁰ My soul hath them still in remembrance, and is humbled in me.
- ²¹ This I recall to my mind, therefore have I hope.
- ²² It is of the LORD'S mercies that we are not consumed, because his compassions fail not.
- ²³ They are new every morning: great is thy faithfulness.
- ²⁴ The LORD is my portion, saith my soul; therefore will I hope in him.
- ²⁵ The LORD is good unto them that wait for him, to the soul that seeketh him.
- 26 It is good that a man should both hope and quietly wait for the salvation of the LORD.
- 27 It is good for a man that he bear the yoke in his youth.
- ²⁸ He sitteth alone and keepeth silence, because he hath borne it upon him.
- ²⁹ He putteth his mouth in the dust; if so be there may be hope.
- 30 He giveth his cheek to him that smiteth him: he is filled full with reproach.
- ³¹ For the Lord will not cast off for ever:
- ³² But though he cause grief, yet will he have compassion according to the multitude of his mercies.
- ³³ For he doth not afflict willingly nor grieve the children of men.
- 34 To crush under his feet all the prisoners of the earth,
- 35 To turn aside the right of a man before the face of the most High,

- ³⁶ To subvert a man in his cause, the Lord approveth not.
- ³⁷ Who is he that saith, and it cometh to pass, when the Lord commandeth it not?
- ³⁸ Out of the mouth of the most High proceedeth not evil and good?
- ³⁹ Wherefore doth a living man complain, a man for the punishment of his sins?
- ⁴⁰ Let us search and try our ways, and turn again to the LORD.
- ⁴¹ Let us lift up our heart with our hands unto God in the heavens.
- ⁴² We have transgressed and have rebelled: thou hast not pardoned.
- 43 Thou hast covered with anger, and persecuted us: thou hast slain, thou hast not pitied.
- ⁴⁴ Thou hast covered thyself with a cloud, that our prayer should not pass through.
- 45 Thou hast made us as the offscouring and refuse in the midst of the people.
- 46 All our enemies have opened their mouths against us.
- ⁴⁷ Fear and a snare is come upon us, desolation and destruction.
- ⁴⁸ Mine eye runneth down with rivers of water for the destruction of the daughter of my people.
- ⁴⁹ Mine eye trickleth down, and ceaseth not, without any intermission,
- 50 Till the LORD look down, and behold from heaven.
- 51 Mine eye affecteth mine heart because of all the daughters of my city.
- 52 Mine enemies chased me sore, like a bird, without cause.
- 53 They have cut off my life in the dungeon, and cast a stone upon me.
- 54 Waters flowed over mine head; then I said, I am cut off.

- 55 I called upon thy name, O LORD, out of the low dungeon.
- ⁵⁶ Thou hast heard my voice: hide not thine ear at my breathing, at my cry.
- 57 Thou drewest near in the day that I called upon thee: thou saidst, Fear not.
- ⁵⁸ O Lord, thou hast pleaded the causes of my soul; thou hast redeemed my life.
- ⁵⁹ O LORD, thou hast seen my wrong: judge thou my cause.
- 60 Thou hast seen all their vengeance and all their imaginations against me.
- ⁶¹ Thou hast heard their reproach, O LORD, and all their imaginations against me;
- 62 The lips of those that rose up against me, and their device against me all the day.
- ⁶³ Behold their sitting down, and their rising up; I am their musick.
- ⁶⁴ Render unto them a recompence, O LORD, according to the work of their hands.
- ⁶⁵ Give them sorrow of heart, thy curse unto them.
- ⁶⁶ Persecute and destroy them in anger from under the heavens of the LORD.

HEBREW & GREEK WORD STUDIES

Faith — אַמוּנַה (Emunah)

Faithfulness, trust

The Hebrew **emunah** (אֱמוּנָה) encompasses both faith and faithfulness—trusting God and being trustworthy. It implies steadfast reliability, as in 'The just shall live by his faith' (Habakkuk 2:4).

God — אַלהים (Elohim)

God (plural of majesty)

The Hebrew **Elohim** (אֱלֹהִים) is a plural form denoting majesty and fullness of deity. Though grammatically plural, it takes singular verbs when referring to the one true God, suggesting the Trinity's plurality within unity.

Heaven — שַׁמֵּים (Shamayim)

Heaven, sky

The Hebrew **shamayim** (שְׁמֵּיִם) means heaven or sky—God's dwelling place and the realm above earth. 'The heaven, even the heavens, are the LORD's' (Psalm 115:16), yet 'the heaven of heavens cannot contain Him' (1 Kings 8:27).

Hope — תָקוַה (Tikvah)

Hope, expectation

The Hebrew **tikvah** (תִּקְוָה) means hope or expectation—confident trust in God's promises. 'Happy is he that hath the God of Jacob for his help, whose hope is in the LORD his God' (Psalm 146:5).

Lord — יְהוָה / אֲדֹנֵי (YHWH / Adonai)

The LORD / Lord

When 'LORD' appears in small capitals, it represents the Tetragrammaton **YHWH** (יְהוָה), God's personal covenant name meaning 'I AM.' When 'Lord' appears normally, it's **Adonai** (אֲדֹנֵי), meaning 'my Lord,' emphasizing sovereignty.

Redeem — נָאַל (Gaal)

To redeem, act as kinsman-redeemer

The Hebrew **gaal** (אַאַ) means to redeem or act as kinsman-redeemer (go'el)—buying back family property or relatives. It foreshadows Christ redeeming His people through His blood.

Repent — שׁוֹב / נַחַם (Shuv / Nacham)

To turn back, relent

The Hebrew **shuv** (שוב) means to turn or return—a physical turning that represents spiritual redirection back to God. **Nacham** (מַחַם) conveys grief or relenting, often used of God 'repenting' of judgment.

Salvation — יִשוּעַה (Yeshuah)

Salvation, deliverance

The Hebrew **yeshuah** (יְשׁוּשָׁה) means salvation or deliverance—rescue from danger or enemies. This is the root of 'Jesus' (Yeshua), meaning 'YHWH saves.'

Sin — חַטַאת (Chatta'ah)

Sin, missing the mark

The Hebrew **chatta'ah** (חַּטָאת) means sin—missing the mark of God's standard. It encompasses rebellion, transgression, and falling short of divine holiness.
