And ye shall keep the charge of the sanctuary, and the charge of the altar: that there be no wrath any more upon the children of Israel.

Analysis

Priests and Levites must 'keep the charge of the sanctuary' so 'there be no wrath any more upon the children of Israel.' Their faithful service protected the entire nation. Mediatorial roles benefit the whole community; failure in representing God brings corporate consequences. This anticipates Christ's perfect priestly work that permanently averts divine wrath from His people.

Historical Context

Recent judgments (Korah's rebellion, plague from murmuring) demonstrated that wrath threatened whenever God's holiness was violated. Proper priestly service maintained the protective buffer between God's holiness and Israel's sinfulness, making continued coexistence possible.

Additional Cross-References

Exodus 27:21 (Temple): In the tabernacle of the congregation without the veil, which is before the testimony, Aaron and his sons shall order it from evening to morning before the LORD: it shall be a statute for ever unto their generations on the behalf of the children of Israel.

Leviticus 24:3 (Temple): Without the veil of the testimony, in the tabernacle of the congregation, shall Aaron order it from the evening unto the morning before the LORD continually: it shall be a statute for ever in your generations.

Numbers 16:46 (Judgment): And Moses said unto Aaron, Take a censer, and put fire therein from off the altar, and put on incense, and go quickly unto the congregation, and make an atonement for them: for there is wrath gone out from the LORD; the plague is begun.
