# Numbers 28

Chapter 28 of 36 · 31 Verses · Authorized King James Version

## **Daily Offerings**

- <sup>1</sup> And the LORD spake unto Moses, saying,
- <sup>2</sup> Command the children of Israel, and say unto them, My offering, and my bread for my sacrifices made by fire, for a sweet savour unto me, shall ye observe to offer unto me in their due season.
- <sup>3</sup> And thou shalt say unto them, This is the offering made by fire which ye shall offer unto the LORD; two lambs of the first year without spot day by day, for a continual burnt offering.
- <sup>4</sup> The one lamb shalt thou offer in the morning, and the other lamb shalt thou offer at even;
- <sup>5</sup> And a tenth part of an ephah of flour for a meat offering, mingled with the fourth part of an hin of beaten oil.
- <sup>6</sup> It is a continual burnt offering, which was ordained in mount Sinai for a sweet savour, a sacrifice made by fire unto the LORD.
- <sup>7</sup> And the drink offering thereof shall be the fourth part of an hin for the one lamb: in the holy place shalt thou cause the strong wine to be poured unto the LORD for a drink offering.
- <sup>8</sup> And the other lamb shalt thou offer at even: as the meat offering of the morning, and as the drink offering thereof, thou shalt offer it, a sacrifice made by fire, of a sweet savour unto the LORD.

## **Sabbath and Monthly Offerings**

- <sup>9</sup> And on the sabbath day two lambs of the first year without spot, and two tenth deals of flour for a meat offering, mingled with oil, and the drink offering thereof:
- <sup>10</sup> This is the burnt offering of every sabbath, beside the continual burnt offering, and his drink offering.
- <sup>11</sup> And in the beginnings of your months ye shall offer a burnt offering unto the LORD; two young bullocks, and one ram, seven lambs of the first year without spot;
- <sup>12</sup> And three tenth deals of flour for a meat offering, mingled with oil, for one bullock; and two tenth deals of flour for a meat offering, mingled with oil, for one ram:
- <sup>13</sup> And a several tenth deal of flour mingled with oil for a meat offering unto one lamb; for a burnt offering of a sweet savour, a sacrifice made by fire unto the LORD.
- <sup>14</sup> And their drink offerings shall be half an hin of wine unto a bullock, and the third part of an hin unto a ram, and a fourth part of an hin unto a lamb: this is the burnt offering of every month throughout the months of the year.
- <sup>15</sup> And one kid of the goats for a sin offering unto the LORD shall be offered, beside the continual burnt offering, and his drink offering.

## **Passover and Festival Offerings**

- $^{16}$  And in the fourteenth day of the first month is the passover of the LORD.
- <sup>17</sup> And in the fifteenth day of this month is the feast: seven days shall unleavened bread be eaten.
- <sup>18</sup> In the first day shall be an holy convocation; ye shall do no manner of servile work therein:
- <sup>19</sup> But ye shall offer a sacrifice made by fire for a burnt offering unto the LORD; two young bullocks, and one ram, and seven lambs of the first year: they shall be unto you without blemish:

- <sup>20</sup> And their meat offering shall be of flour mingled with oil: three tenth deals shall ye offer for a bullock, and two tenth deals for a ram;
- <sup>21</sup> A several tenth deal shalt thou offer for every lamb, throughout the seven lambs:
- <sup>22</sup> And one goat for a sin offering, to make an atonement for you.
- <sup>23</sup> Ye shall offer these beside the burnt offering in the morning, which is for a continual burnt offering.
- <sup>24</sup> After this manner ye shall offer daily, throughout the seven days, the meat of the sacrifice made by fire, of a sweet savour unto the LORD: it shall be offered beside the continual burnt offering, and his drink offering.
- <sup>25</sup> And on the seventh day ye shall have an holy convocation; ye shall do no servile work.
- <sup>26</sup> Also in the day of the firstfruits, when ye bring a new meat offering unto the LORD, after your weeks be out, ye shall have an holy convocation; ye shall do no servile work:
- <sup>27</sup> But ye shall offer the burnt offering for a sweet savour unto the LORD; two young bullocks, one ram, seven lambs of the first year;
- <sup>28</sup> And their meat offering of flour mingled with oil, three tenth deals unto one bullock, two tenth deals unto one ram,
- $^{29}$  A several tenth deal unto one lamb, throughout the seven lambs;
- $^{30}$  And one kid of the goats, to make an atonement for you.
- $^{31}$  Ye shall offer them beside the continual burnt offering, and his meat offering, (they shall be unto you without blemish) and their drink offerings.

### **HEBREW & GREEK WORD STUDIES**

Atonement — פַפר (Kaphar)

To cover, make atonement,

The Hebrew **kaphar** (פָפַר) means to cover or make atonement—the basis for Yom Kippur (Day of Atonement). The blood of sacrifices covered sin: 'it is the blood that maketh an atonement for the soul' (Leviticus 17:11).

Holy — קדוש (Qadosh)

Holy, set apart

The Hebrew **qadosh** (קַדוֹש) means holy or set apart—separated from common use for God's purposes. God is 'the Holy One of Israel,' utterly distinct from creation in moral perfection.

**Lamb** — שָׂה / כֶּבֶשׂ (Seh / Kebes)

Lamb, young sheep

The Hebrew **seh** (שָׁה) denotes a lamb—central to Israel's sacrificial system. The Passover lamb's blood protected Israel from judgment (Exodus 12), and Isaiah prophesied the Servant would be 'brought as a lamb to the slaughter' (Isaiah 53:7).

**Lord** — יָהוָה / אֲדֹנַי (YHWH / Adonai)

The LORD / Lord

When 'LORD' appears in small capitals, it represents the Tetragrammaton **YHWH** (הְוָהוְּ), God's personal covenant name meaning 'I AM.' When 'Lord' appears normally, it's **Adonai** (אֲדֹנְיִ), meaning 'my Lord,' emphasizing sovereignty.

Sin — חַטָּאת (Chatta'ah)

Sin, missing the mark

The Hebrew **chatta'ah** (חַפָּאת) means sin—missing the mark of God's standard. It encompasses rebellion, transgression, and falling short of divine holiness.
