The way of life is above to the wise, that he may depart from hell beneath.

Analysis

The way of life is above to the wise, that he may depart from hell beneath. Orach chayyim lema'alah lemaskil (אֹרַח חַיִּים לְמַעַלְהָ לְמַשְׁכִּיל, the path of life upward for the wise). The wise walk an upward path toward life. Lema'an sur mishe'ol matah (לְמַעַן יִסּוּר מִשְׁאוֹל מֵתַח, in order to turn from Sheol below). This upward path's purpose: avoiding She'ol (שְׁאוֹל, grave, realm of death) below. The imagery is spatial but theological—the wise pursue life heavenward, escaping downward death. Jesus is the way upward (John 14:6), and believers are raised with Him (Colossians 3:1-2).

Historical Context

Ancient cosmology pictured Sheol beneath the earth, while life and blessing came from above. This proverb uses that framework to teach that wisdom's path ascends toward God and life, while folly's path descends toward death. The New Testament clarifies—Christ descended to the grave and ascended to heaven (Ephesians 4:8-10), making a way for believers to ascend with Him.

1. Is your life trajectory upward toward God and life, or downward toward death?
