

# Proverbs 2:6

Authorized King James Version (KJV)

For the LORD giveth wisdom: out of his mouth cometh knowledge and understanding.

## Analysis

---

This verse reveals the divine source of wisdom. After commanding pursuit of wisdom (vv.1-5), Solomon declares that 'the LORD giveth wisdom' (יְהוָה יֵתֵן חֵכְמָה / Yahweh yiten chokhmah). Human effort alone cannot produce wisdom—it is God's gift. 'Out of his mouth cometh knowledge and understanding' emphasizes revelation: wisdom flows from God's self-disclosure in His word. This anticipates the New Testament's fuller revelation that Christ is the wisdom of God (1 Corinthians 1:24, 30) and that God's word makes us wise unto salvation (2 Timothy 3:15). The verse balances human responsibility (seek wisdom diligently) with divine sovereignty (God gives wisdom). James 1:5 echoes this: 'If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally.'

## Historical Context

---

This verse reflects the ancient Near Eastern understanding that true wisdom originates from the divine realm.
