- ¹ Be not thou envious against evil men, neither desire to be with them.
- ² For their heart studieth destruction, and their lips talk of mischief.
- ³ Through wisdom is an house builded; and by understanding it is established:
- ⁴ And by knowledge shall the chambers be filled with all precious and pleasant riches.
- ⁵ A wise man is strong; yea, a man of knowledge increaseth strength.
- ⁶ For by wise counsel thou shalt make thy war: and in multitude of counsellors there is safety.
- 7 Wisdom is too high for a fool: he openeth not his mouth in the gate.
- $^{8}\,$ He that deviseth to do evil shall be called a mischievous person.

- ¹⁸ Lest the LORD see it, and it displease him, and he turn away his wrath from him.
- ¹⁹ Fret not thyself because of evil men, neither be thou envious at the wicked;
- 20 For there shall be no reward to the evil man; the candle of the wicked shall be put out.

Further Sayings of the Wise

- 23 These things also belong to the wise. It is not good to have respect of persons in judgment.
- He that saith unto the wicked, Thou art righteous; him shall the people curse, nations shall abhor him:
- ²⁵ But to them that rebuke him shall be delight, and a good blessing shall come upon them.

- ²⁶ Every man shall kiss his lips that giveth a right answer.
- ²⁷ Prepare thy work without, and make it fit for thyself in the field; and afterwards build thine house.
- ²⁸ Be not a witness against thy neighbour without cause; and deceive not with thy lips.
- ²⁹ Say not, I will do so to him as he hath done to me: I will render to the man according to his work.
- 30 I went by the field of the slothful, and by the vineyard of the man void of understanding;

HEBREW & GREEK WORD STUDIES

Judgment — מִשְׁפַּט (Mishpat)

Judgment, justice

The Hebrew **mishpat** (מִשְּׁפֵט) means judgment or justice—God's righteous decisions and ordinances. God is the Judge of all the earth who 'shall do right' (Genesis 18:25), executing perfect justice.

Lord — יָהוַה / אָדֹנֵי (YHWH / Adonai)

The LORD / Lord

When 'LORD' appears in small capitals, it represents the Tetragrammaton **YHWH** (הְּוָהְיִ), God's personal covenant name meaning 'I AM.' When 'Lord' appears normally, it's **Adonai** (אֲדֹנָי), meaning 'my Lord,' emphasizing sovereignty.

Righteous — צַדִּיק (Tzaddik)

Righteous one

The Hebrew **tzaddik** (צַּדִּיק) describes one who is righteous, just, or lawful—conforming to God's standard. From the root tzedek (צָּדָק), meaning righteousness or justice.

Sin — מַטָאת (Chatta'ah)

Sin, missing the mark

The Hebrew **chatta'ah** (חַפָּאת) means sin—missing the mark of God's standard. It encompasses rebellion, transgression, and falling short of divine holiness.

Wrath — אַף (Aph)

Wrath, anger

The Hebrew aph (אַס) literally means 'nose' or 'nostrils,' idiomatically expressing wrath or anger —God's righteous indignation against sin. Yet God is 'slow to anger' (Exodus 34:6) and 'abundant in mercy.'
