## Trust in the Lord with All Your Heart

- <sup>1</sup> My son, forget not my law; but let thine heart keep my commandments:
- <sup>2</sup> For length of days, and long life, and peace, shall they add to thee.
- <sup>3</sup> Let not mercy and truth forsake thee: bind them about thy neck; write them upon the table of thine heart:
- <sup>4</sup> So shalt thou find favour and good understanding in the sight of God and man.
- <sup>5</sup> Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding.
- <sup>6</sup> In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths.
- $^{7}\,$  Be not wise in thine own eyes: fear the LORD, and depart from evil.
- <sup>8</sup> It shall be health to thy navel, and marrow to thy bones.
- <sup>9</sup> Honour the LORD with thy substance, and with the firstfruits of all thine increase:

### Blessed Is the One Who Finds Wisdom

- <sup>13</sup> Happy is the man that findeth wisdom, and the man that getteth understanding.
- For the merchandise of it is better than the merchandise of silver, and the gain thereof than fine gold.
- $^{15}$  She is more precious than rubies: and all the things thou canst desire are not to be compared unto her.
- <sup>16</sup> Length of days is in her right hand; and in her left hand riches and honour.
- <sup>17</sup> Her ways are ways of pleasantness, and all her paths are peace.
- <sup>18</sup> She is a tree of life to them that lay hold upon her: and happy is every one that retaineth her.
- <sup>19</sup> The LORD by wisdom hath founded the earth; by understanding hath he established the heavens.
- $^{20}$  By his knowledge the depths are broken up, and the clouds drop down the dew.
- $^{21}$  My son, let not them depart from thine eyes: keep sound wisdom and discretion:
- $^{22}$  So shall they be life unto thy soul, and grace to thy neck.
- $^{23}$  Then shalt thou walk in thy way safely, and thy foot shall not stumble.
- <sup>24</sup> When thou liest down, thou shalt not be afraid: yea, thou shalt lie down, and thy sleep shall be sweet.
- <sup>25</sup> Be not afraid of sudden fear, neither of the desolation of the wicked, when it cometh.

 $<sup>^{26}</sup>$  For the LORD shall be thy confidence, and shall keep thy foot from being taken.

# **Instructions for Daily Living**

- Withhold not good from them to whom it is due, when it is in the power of thine hand to do it.
- <sup>28</sup> Say not unto thy neighbour, Go, and come again, and to morrow I will give; when thou hast it by thee.
- <sup>29</sup> Devise not evil against thy neighbour, seeing he dwelleth securely by thee.
- <sup>30</sup> Strive not with a man without cause, if he have done thee no harm.
- <sup>31</sup> Envy thou not the oppressor, and choose none of his ways.
- <sup>32</sup> For the froward is abomination to the LORD: but his secret is with the righteous.
- <sup>33</sup> The curse of the LORD is in the house of the wicked: but he blesseth the habitation of the just.
- <sup>34</sup> Surely he scorneth the scorners: but he giveth grace unto the lowly.

#### **HEBREW & GREEK WORD STUDIES**

(Kavod) כַּבוֹד **Glory** – כַּבוֹד

Glory, weight, honor

The Hebrew **kavod** (קבוֹד) literally means 'weight' or 'heaviness,' metaphorically denoting glory, honor, or majesty. God's glory (Shekinah) filled the tabernacle (Exodus 40:34) and temple (1 Kings 8:11).

God — אֱלֹהִים (Elohim)

God (plural of majesty)

The Hebrew **Elohim** (אֱלֹהִים) is a plural form denoting majesty and fullness of deity. Though grammatically plural, it takes singular verbs when referring to the one true God, suggesting the Trinity's plurality within unity.

# Grace — וחַ (Chen)

#### Grace, favor

The Hebrew **chen** (n) means grace or favor—unmerited kindness bestowed by a superior. Noah 'found grace in the eyes of the LORD' (Genesis 6:8), receiving undeserved favor.

## Heaven — שַׁמֵּים (Shamayim)

#### Heaven, sky

The Hebrew **shamayim** (שְׁמֵּיִם) means heaven or sky—God's dwelling place and the realm above earth. 'The heaven, even the heavens, are the LORD's' (Psalm 115:16), yet 'the heaven of heavens cannot contain Him' (1 Kings 8:27).

## Law — תוֹרָה (Torah)

#### Law, instruction

The Hebrew **Torah** (תּוֹכָה) means law or instruction—God's revealed will for His people. The Law includes moral, civil, and ceremonial commandments, revealing God's character and humanity's need for a Savior.

## **Lord** — יָהוָה / אֵדֹנֵי (YHWH / Adonai)

#### The LORD / Lord

When 'LORD' appears in small capitals, it represents the Tetragrammaton **YHWH** (הְּוָהְיִּ), God's personal covenant name meaning 'I AM.' When 'Lord' appears normally, it's **Adonai** (אָדֹנְיִי), meaning 'my Lord,' emphasizing sovereignty.

# Love — אַהֶּבָה / חֶסֶד (Ahavah / Chesed)

#### Love / Loyal-love

Hebrew uses **ahavah** (אַהֶּבָּה) for love generally, but the covenant term **chesed** (תְּסֶּד) describes God's steadfast, loyal love—faithful covenant commitment beyond mere emotion.

## Mercy — רַחַמִּים (Rachamim)

## Compassion, mercy

The Hebrew **rachamim** (בַּחָמִים) derives from 'womb' (rechem), suggesting tender, maternal compassion. God's mercies are 'new every morning' (Lamentations 3:23), showing His compassionate nature.

#### Truth — אֶמֶת (Emet)

#### Truth, faithfulness

The Hebrew **emet** (אֶמֶת) means truth or faithfulness—reliability and conformity to reality. God is true (emet), utterly faithful to His word and character.
