

# Psalm 106:27

Authorized King James Version (KJV)

To overthrow their seed also among the nations, and to scatter them in the lands.

## Analysis

---

This verse expands God's oath of judgment beyond the wilderness generation. 'To overthrow their seed also among the nations' prophesies exile—Israel's descendants would be scattered among pagan nations. 'To scatter them in the lands' uses *zarah* (זרה), meaning to winnow, disperse, or scatter like chaff. This was fulfilled in the Assyrian exile (722 BC) and Babylonian captivity (586 BC), and later diaspora. God's covenant included generational blessings for obedience and curses for disobedience (Deuteronomy 28:30). The sins of one generation bring consequences on descendants, demonstrating the corporate nature of covenant and the seriousness of covenant-breaking.

## Historical Context

---

While the immediate context is the wilderness generation's judgment, this verse prophetically extends to future exile as covenant curse. Deuteronomy 28:64-68 and Leviticus 26:33 warned of scattering among nations if Israel broke covenant. These warnings were fulfilled through Assyrian and Babylonian conquests. For post-exilic Israel reciting this psalm, it explained their recent exile as God fulfilling His oath of covenant curse for persistent idolatry and rebellion.
