

# Psalms 11

Chapter 11 of 150 · 7 Verses · Authorized King James Version

---

## **The Lord Is in His Holy Temple**

- 1** In the LORD put I my trust: how say ye to my soul, Flee as a bird to your mountain?
- 2** For, lo, the wicked bend their bow, they make ready their arrow upon the string, that they may privily shoot at the upright in heart.
- 3** If the foundations be destroyed, what can the righteous do?

- 4** The LORD is in his holy temple, the LORD'S throne is in heaven: his eyes behold, his eyelids try, the children of men.
- 5** The LORD trieth the righteous: but the wicked and him that loveth violence his soul hateth.
- 6** Upon the wicked he shall rain snares, fire and brimstone, and an horrible tempest: this shall be the portion of their cup.
- 7** For the righteous LORD loveth righteousness; his countenance doth behold the upright.

## HEBREW & GREEK WORD STUDIES

### Heaven — שָׁמַיִם (Shamayim)

Heaven, sky

The Hebrew **shamayim** (שָׁמַיִם) means heaven or sky—God's dwelling place and the realm above earth. 'The heaven, even the heavens, are the LORD's' (Psalm 115:16), yet 'the heaven of heavens cannot contain Him' (1 Kings 8:27).

### Lord — יְהֹוָה / אֲדֹנָי (YHWH / Adonai)

The LORD / Lord

When 'LORD' appears in small capitals, it represents the Tetragrammaton **YHWH** (יְהֹוָה), God's personal covenant name meaning 'I AM.' When 'Lord' appears normally, it's **Adonai** (אֲדֹנָי), meaning 'my Lord,' emphasizing sovereignty.

### Love — אֶחָד / אַהֲבָה (Ahavah / Chesed)

Love / Loyal-love

Hebrew uses **ahavah** (אֶחָד) for love generally, but the covenant term **chesed** (אַהֲבָה) describes God's steadfast, loyal love—faithful covenant commitment beyond mere emotion.

### Righteous — צַדִּיק (Tzaddik)

Righteous one

The Hebrew **tzaddik** (צַדִּיק) describes one who is righteous, just, or lawful—conforming to God's standard. From the root **tzedek** (צִדְקָה), meaning righteousness or justice.
