Blessed Is the Man Who Fears the Lord

- ¹ Praise ye the LORD. Blessed is the man that feareth the LORD, that delighteth greatly in his commandments.
- ² His seed shall be mighty upon earth: the generation of the upright shall be blessed.
- ³ Wealth and riches shall be in his house: and his righteousness endureth for ever.
- ⁴ Unto the upright there ariseth light in the darkness: he is gracious, and full of compassion, and righteous.
- ⁵ A good man sheweth favour, and lendeth: he will guide his affairs with discretion.
- ⁶ Surely he shall not be moved for ever: the righteous shall be in everlasting remembrance.
- 7 He shall not be afraid of evil tidings: his heart is fixed, trusting in the LORD.
- ⁸ His heart is established, he shall not be afraid, until he see his desire upon his enemies.
- ⁹ He hath dispersed, he hath given to the poor; his righteousness endureth for ever; his horn shall be exalted with honour.
- The wicked shall see it, and be grieved; he shall gnash with his teeth, and melt away: the desire of the wicked shall perish.

HEBREW & GREEK WORD STUDIES

Lord — יָהוָה / אֵדֹנֵי (YHWH / Adonai)

The LORD / Lord

When 'LORD' appears in small capitals, it represents the Tetragrammaton **YHWH** (הְּוָהְיִ), God's personal covenant name meaning 'I AM.' When 'Lord' appears normally, it's **Adonai** (אָדֹנְיִי), meaning 'my Lord,' emphasizing sovereignty.

Righteous — צַדִּיק (Tzaddik)

Righteous one

The Hebrew **tzaddik** (צַּדִּיק) describes one who is righteous, just, or lawful—conforming to God's standard. From the root tzedek (צֶּדֶק), meaning righteousness or justice.
