## **Unless the Lord Builds the House**

## **HEBREW & GREEK WORD STUDIES**

Lord — יָהוָה / אֲדֹנָי (YHWH / Adonai)

The LORD / Lord

When 'LORD' appears in small capitals, it represents the Tetragrammaton **YHWH** (יְהוָה), God's personal covenant name meaning 'I AM.' When 'Lord' appears normally, it's **Adonai** (יְאַדֹנָי), meaning 'my Lord,' emphasizing sovereignty.
